GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months

of age that are:

- (a) Individually registered with the CKC,
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed

ENTRY LIMIT: Entries will be limited to 30 runs per test.

Post (day of) test entries will be accepted prior to the time of handlers' meeting for each test, if space is available.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (cont'd)

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

Border Crossing: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

TEST SITE: Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run **rain or shine**. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test. **Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site.** Remember that this is a public park used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog.

No dogs are allowed near the washrooms or food area or on the pavilion.

Bathroom facilities and food are available on site.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Chase Ability Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Tel: 1-800-250-8040.

CKC Regulation It shall be the duty and obligation of the trialgiving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
