LIMITED ENTRY

Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to perform at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice dogs per hour, 8 Novice dogs per hour, 7 Open dogs per hour, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. Entry in Obedience Trials 1 & 2 will be limited to a total of 7 hours of judging. Once the judge has reached her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list.

If the club is notified after entries are closed, that a bitch in season will be absent, it may be substituted with an entry from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. Per CKC rules, fees will not be refunded for any reason other than a bitch being in season and to those on the reserve list who did not participate in the trial.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

NEW – CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

- 1. A non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- 2. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- 3. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and are not applicable to CKC members.

U.S.A. EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry, will be accepted.

Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured.

Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 4. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
- 5. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.
- 6. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 7. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 18, 2017, 9:00pm OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- 8. Judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the close date.
- 9. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$30.00 service charge.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The K-W Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- 4. The trial precincts shall be the entire building of Companion Dog Training.
- 5. **Mix Breeds and Unrecognized Breeds** must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the CKC to enter the trials. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

Obedience Class Eligibility In all cases where you are unsure of eligibility please review the actual CKC Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations. The following is included for your convenience only, and is not the full wording of the eligibility definitions:

Pr e-Novice (section 9.1.6 in the CKC Rules) is for a dog which has not earned a CD

Novice A (section 10.1 in the CKC Rules) is for a dog which has not earned a CD, and the handler must be the owner, co-owner or a member of the immediate family. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

Novice B (section 10.2 in the CKC Rules) is for a dog which has not earned a CD, the handler may be the owner or any other person.

Novice C (section 10.3 in the CKC Rules) is for a dog that has earned the title CD, CDX, UD or any OTCh title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Scores earned in Novice C are not eligible for High In Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. The handler may be the owner or any other person.

Novice Intermediate (section 11.1 in the CKC Rules) is for a dog which has earned a CD, CDX, UD or any OTCh. Scores in this class are not eligible for High In Trial

Open A (section 12.1 in the CKC Rules) is for any dog which has earned a CD but has not earned a CDX. The handler must be the owner or a member of their immediate family, and no person who has trained or ex hibited a dog which has earned a UD may handle a dog in Open A

Open B (section 12.2.2 in the CKC Rules) dogs which have a CDX or UD must enter the Open B class, and handlers may be the owner or any other person

Utility A (section 13.1 in the CKC Rules) is for a dog which has a CDX but has not earned a UD. The handler must not have trained or ex hibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch and must be the owner or a member of the immediate family

Utility B (section 13.2 in the CKC Rules) is for a dog which has a CDX or UD and the handler may be the owner or any other person.

DIRECTIONS TO COMPANION DOG TRAINING

From the East: Take Hwy. 401 to Hwy 6 North (exit 295). Turn left at the 1st set of lights (Wellington Rd. 34). At roundabout take County Rd. 35 south. After crossing the 401, turn left at the first road (Concession 2). Turn left at the first driveway. Look for fire signs 6926 or 6924.

From the West: Take Hwy 401 to Townline Rd. (exit 286). Turn right at the lights off the 401, then left at the next set of lights (Lake Rd.). Follow this road until you come to a stop sign (small lake on your right). Keep right at the stop sign , and the road turns into Concession 2. After the stop sign for County Rd. 35, turn left into the first driveway. Look for fire signs 6926 or 6924.

From the North: Take the Hanlon Expressway (Hwy. 6) south to Downey Rd. (YMCA on the corner). Turn right and follow this road. After crossing the 401, turn left at the first road (Concession 2). Turn left at the first driveway. Look for fire signs 6926 or 6924.

From the South: Take Hwy. 6 towards Guelph. After the highway goes from 4 lanes to 2, you will go over a railroad bridge. Look for the sign for Leslie Rd. and turn left (if you get to the little town of Morriston, you've gone too far). Follow Lelise Rd. to Sideroad 20 and turn right. Sideroad 20 dead ends at Concession 2. Turn left. It is the 5th or 6th property on the right. Look for fire signs 6926 or 6924. If you get to County Rd. 35, you've gone too far.
