Baby Puppy - 3 months and under 6 months Junior Puppy - 6 months and under 9 months Senior Puppy - 9 months and under 12 months Intermediate - 12 months and under 15 months Open - 15 months and under 18 months All class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Money received as entry fees will be divided as follows:

1st in each class will divide 30% of the prize money 2nd in each class will divide 25% of the prize mon-

3rd in each class will divide 15% of the prize money 4th in each class will divide 5% of the prize money Best in Sweepstakes will receive 10% plus a prize Best Opposite Sex will receive 5% plus a prize Rosettes will be offered for the above placings 10% will be held for administration costs.

MOVING A DOG TO SPECIALS

Chapter 13, Section 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which is "INDIVIDUALLY REGISTERED AT TIME OF CLOSING" in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW by the owner or handler.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy: A dog between 3 mos. & under 6 mos. on day of show.

Junior Puppy: A dog between 6 mos. & under 9 mos. on day of show.

Senior Puppy: A dog between 9 mos. & under 12 mos. on day of show.

12 - 18 Month: A dog between 12 mos. & under 18 mos. on day of show.

Canadian Bred: A dog born in Canada Bred By Exhibitor: Handler of the dog is also the breeder & owner.

CONFORMATION CLASSES CONTINUED

Open Class: For all dogs

Veterans Class: For all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements, and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only: Dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

Unofficial Classes:

Gun Dog Class: Dogs must have a Field Title, Hunt Title or Working Certificate Title to enter this class. Dogs must be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only at the Specialty Show to participate in this class.

Stud Dog Class: Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

Brood Bitch: Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood Bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

Brace: Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. 

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st place through to 4th place in each class. Prizes will be awarded for 1st place only in each class. High in Trial will receive a Rosette and a Prize.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete under C.K.C. Rules. We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trials. This certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.

PHOTOGRAPHER

There will not be a professional photographer on the site, however some members will be taking pictures.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective Jan. 1/92 all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$59.40 per dog plus applicable taxes. For further information contact: The Canadian Kennel Club

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds for the full amount of the entry will be accepted. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog may be entered as a 'listed dog', except that a dog which has obtained three qualifying scores at obedience trials held under C.K.C. rules, may not continue to compete at licensed obedience trials held under the Club's rules until the dog is registered individually with the C.K.C. Foreign born and owned dogs, please refer to Event Registration Number (ERN) information listed below.

Dogs in obedience must wear a well-fitted plain buckle or slip collar. Slip collars of any appropriate single length of leather, fabric or chain with two rings, one at each end, are acceptable. There shall be nothing hanging from the collar.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2012:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.
Chapter 19 - Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

GENERAL INFORMATION

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club we will be unable to accept, cancel, or substitute an entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing date.

- * All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be mailed or emailed as soon as possible after entries close.
- * It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.
- * Refunds will not be given for anyone double entering the same dog.
- * All exhibitors should review Section 4 Judges General, also section 1.3 of the CKC Conformation Rules & Regulations, "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subjected to indignities."
- * Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- * It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged.
- * The Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club of Canada, its officers & associates will use due care & diligence for the welfare of dogs, spectators, and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, and it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. *The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of the show and / or trial, which will be governed by the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC)
- * SHOW PRECINCTS 30 feet from each ring
- * Best In Show Services will only collect and utilize data and information that you provide us, and only for the purposes of the service we provide, exhibitors entering a CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) event, and the subsequent documents generated for this event, and required by the CKC. The type and accuracy of the information is solely contingent upon what you voluntarily provide us with. We will not use or disclose personal information for the purposed other than those for which it was collected, except with consent or as required by law. Personal information will not be retained longer than needed for the specified purposes.

UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES - VETERANS CLASS

The Veterans Class shall be for any dog that has earned the title of C.D. or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Classes.

The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class.

A person may enter more than one dog in this

The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises.
