ENTRIES CLOSE: either at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014 or when the respective limits are reached. (Refer rule 6.2.1)

Entries received prior to the opening date (April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2014) will be discarded and all duplicate entries received for the same dog in one event on or after the opening date will be discarded.

# GENERAL INFORMATION MAKE ALL CHEQUES/MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO ALBERTA KENNEL CLUB

# PLEASE NOTE Only entries received via Canada Post will be accepted

No post dated cheques. No Entry will be accepted without payment in full. Tendering of a N.S.F. cheque in payment of entry fees is considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. **All N.S.F.** cheques will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge.

The owner of a dog entered in this test is entirely responsible for any errors in the entering of the dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

Rule 4.1(m): A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club (\$8.40 plus 5% GST) must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) or Performance Event Number (PEN) is not shown on the entry form. A dog that is eligible for a Performance Event Number (PEN) cannot be entered as a listed dog. Event Registration Numbers: Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$59.40 +5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. #### PLEASE NOTE TO ALL NON-MEMBERS OF The Canadian Kennel Club.

Effective January 1st, 2011 an annual non-member participation fee for all awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee \$59.40 + 5%GST. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the Non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non CKC members and not dogs co-owned by a CKC member.

Entries shall not be accepted from any person who is not in good standing with The Canadian Kennel Club on the day of entries closing. U.S. entrants may pay fees by money order payable in Canadian funds OR by personal cheque in U.S. funds for the full amount of the fees. Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted and please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" as these will not be accepted.

#### RECEIPT OF ENTRIES AND ASSIGNMENT OF POSITIONS

We will be accepting entries by CANADA POST ONLY. EACH ENTRY MUST BE MAILED IN A SEPARATE ENVELOPE (Rule 6.1.19). No hand delivered, telephone, faxed, courier or emailed entries will be accepted. **All entries must be sent NO** 

# SIGNATURE REQUIRED

Once the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position on the "Alternate List" in the order that they are received. The Test Secretary will notify the entrant by email on the day the entry is received. Confirmation of entries position of the exhibitor, or alternate list will be provided by email on the closing date.

Dog Show Rule books, Tracking Test regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy. Please familiarize yourself with the new 2013 CKC Tracking Test Rules that came into effect January 1, 2013. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to these trials.

### **REFUNDS**

Withdrawn entries after closing date will only be refunded where there is an "Alternate" available who chooses to fill that assigned entrants vacancy on test day. Alternates will be contacted in catalogue order and advised of the opening – they may choose to accept the spot and become responsible for the entry fee or decline and bear no financial obligation.

Anyone on the "Alternate List" may request a refund at any time prior to test day. Entries will be refunded within 10 days of the test date to those on the alternate list that did not participate in the test.

RENDEZVOUS AND TRACK DRAW is scheduled to take place at Wetnoses Bed and Biscuit training facility located on Hwy 24 just south of 22X in Carseland at 8:00 a.m.. Map provided. Do not contact Wetnoses Bed and Biscuit with anything pertaining to this test – they are simply providing land and will not answer questions or pass messages on. Place, Date and time are subject to change should any unforeseen circumstances arise. Entrants will be notified of any changes via email or telephone, if required. It is important that entrants provide a cell number where they can be reached for any change in directions up to the draw time. Entrants will be provided with Secretary/Superintendent cell phone contact numbers for test day should any issues arise. Please note that tracks for TD and TDX will be run in catalogue order within their level of test but that the overall organization of TD and TDX tracks may be intermingled throughout the day. (I.e. the first 2 TD tracks may run and then a TDX may run, followed by a TD track etc... until all tracks are completed.) There is approximately a 30 minute drive between the two areas of land that are secured for this test.

#### **BITCHES IN SEASON**

Bitches in Season will run last.

#### **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

In attending this test, competitors, spectators and guests acknowledge they do so at their own risk and that of any dog. They also agree they will not hold liable the C.K.C., Alberta Kennel Club or its test officials, the Judge or the land owner(s) for any loss, damage or injury, however arising, to themselves, their dog(s), or any chattels.

# **DISCIPLINE-INDIGNITIES (Rule 14.7)**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to **indignities** of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

AWARDS will take place after the last track has run. Ribbons will be distributed to those with passing results.

**PARKING:** Parking at the site of the tests will be street or private – please be respectful of the landowners and traffic on the rural roads. Please be sure to bring your own shade screens and water.
