OFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - for dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY – for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12-18 MONTHS – for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED – for dogs born in Canada. Champions of any other country are excluded

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the Owner/Co-Owner and breeder/Co-Breeder of the dog. The Owner/Breeder **MUST** handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN – for all dogs

VETERAN – for all dogs over the age of 7 years as of the date of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY – for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration number and have attained the required points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

EXHIBITION ONLY – all dogs entered shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular Classes

NON-REGULAR AND UNOFFICIAL CLASSSES

SIRE AND GET is an entry that comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud dog must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in the Stud Dog and Get Class may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a regular class as outlined in these rules or for exhibition only.

DAM AND PROGENY is an entry that comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in the Dam And Progeny Class may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a regular class as outlined in these rules or for exhibition only.

BRACE – is a class that shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). (Note: effective January 1, 2006 – identical ownership no longer applies). Class shall be judged after Best of Breed.

PARADES – Veterans, Titleholders: Dogs entered in these Parades MUST be entered in a regular class at this Specialty or for EXHIBITION ONLY. Please submit a brief summary about your "star" that can be read at the Specialty & printed in the catalogue. Send your write up to: Louise Davie (CompuPets Internet Inc.) info@compupets.com

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class will be judged after the judging of the Best of Breed in the Regular classes

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will compete for Best Altered in Breed

PROPERTY CLASSES (Unofficial)

Will be held following Sweepstakes judging

Altered dogs may also compete. Each class is a separate entry. Dogs and bitches will be judged together, with the exception of "Best Head", dogs and bitches will be judged separately. All dogs being entered in the Property Classes MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only within the Specialty. Classes offered are as follows:

Most Alert Best Colour Best Coat Texture
