CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

TO COMPETE IN THE JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASS, DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS, OR FOR SPECIALS ONLY. ENTRY IN THE JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED. DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES MAY BE ENTERED IN EXHIBITION ONLY. Sweepstakes will follow the Rally & Obedience Trials on Friday evening.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL - April 1, 2011

Friday evening after Red Deer & District Kennel Club's Best in Show

The following obedience classes will be offered:

Novice A; Novice B; Open A; Open B & Utility; Pre-Novice, Brace & Veterans.

Please ensure jump height is indicated on entry form for Open and Utility.

Regular Obedience Classes

Novice A for any purebred dog that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Novice B for any purebred dog that has not earned the title of CD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class.

Open A for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class. Open B for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CD, CDX or UD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class. A dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial.

<u>Utility</u> for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CDX in CANADA.

Transition Obedience Class (N.B. Scores earned by dogs entered in Transition Classes are not eligible for High in Trial.)

<u>Pre-Novice</u> For any purebred dog that has not earned the PCD or CD title. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class but must have an additional handler for each dog when judged together in Group Exercise.

<u>Unofficial Obedience Classes</u> PLEASE NOTE: Dogs entered in non-regular or unofficial classes must be entered in a regular class in the trial or for Exhibition Only.

Brace two dogs of either sex that have attained at least a Canadian CD title, not necessarily with the same ownership.

Veteran Dogs which have attained at least a Canadian CD title and are age seven years or older.

RALLY TRIAL - April 1, 2011

Friday evening after Red Deer & District Kennel Club's Best in Show

The following rally classes will be offered:

Novice A; Novice B; Advanced A; Advanced B; Excellent A; Excellent B

Please ensure jump height is indicated on entry form for Advanced and Excellent. Regular Obedience Classes

Novice A Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R. N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

<u>Novice B</u> Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Advanced A This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Advanced B This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Excellent A This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Excellent B This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Exhibition Only Obedience/Rally For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club

<u>Entry fees</u> will be refunded when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the Trial. The Newfoundland Dog Fanciers of Alberta will refund entry, recording & listing fees if the above conditions are met.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$57.60. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Red Deer & District Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- 2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt and judging schedules. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.

<u>Please note</u>: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone or <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the time and date of the <u>official closing</u>. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.</u>

19.7 CKC RULES

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

15.1 Championship Points

- 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.
- 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:
- *Includes the dog awarded Winners

*DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3- 5	6-9	10-12	13
POINTS ALLOCATED	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

- 15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section. Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

- 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:
- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and, (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN).
- (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.
- 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:
- (a) 3 or more Winners awards at not less than 3 different shows, under 3 different judges at the breed level;
- (b) each of the 3 Winners awards must have earned one or more championship points, not necessarily at the breed level;
- (c) all the points required for championship status may be earned at the breed or group level or a combination of both breed and group level.

IMPORTANT NOTICE NEW TRACKING FEE FOR CANADIAN NON-MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all <u>Canadian</u> residents who participate in CKC events, but are not CKC members. In order to cover the clerical costs of recording and tracking points and awards earned at CKC events, a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay a <u>dog specific</u> tracking fee of \$55.00. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it is important that nonmembers select one of the two options within 30 days of notification, or unfortunately, the points, awards and titles will be cancelled. OFFICE USE
