Entries close at **10:00pm on Saturday August 4th**, or when entry limit (40 dogs) is reached.

No entries may be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries except as provided for in these rules.

Note: Move-ups will be allowed after completion of each stake.

Dogs entered in and successfully completing the WC or WCI test may MOVE UP to the next level test. Move-up requests must be submitted on official entry form within 15 minutes of ribbon presentation for previous test, accompanied by additional entry fee (cash only).

TEST DETAILS

- Please check-in with Test Secretary upon arrival.
- All dogs must be kept under control <u>at all times</u> on test grounds.
- Bitches in season will NOT be allowed to run in the tests and should NOT be brought onto test grounds. Refunds will be given upon receipt of a veterinarian certificate <u>prior</u> to the start of the test.
- Please respect the landowners that have graciously allowed us access to their property. Drive and park only in designated areas and remove all garbage and debris.
- Airing of dogs is only allowed in designated areas (away from tests and upcoming tests) please check with Test Marshalls and you MUST pick up after your dog.
- Birds: Ducks will be used on land and water.
- **Clothing:** All handlers and spectators must wear dark or camouflage clothing. Light coloured clothing is not allowed in the vicinity of the tests (except for handlers when running blinds in the WCX).
- **Running order:** Running order will be determined by random draw after entries close. Wherever possible, handlers with more than one dog will run in non-consecutive order. Running orders will be emailed to entrants when finalized, and available at the test. Dayof move-ups will be added to pre-determined running order at the discretion of the event secretary.
- **Catalogue:** WC/I/X Test catalogues & running orders will be available at the tests.
- Rules: Entrants are strongly encouraged to familiarize themselves with the rules of the test(s) they intend to run. Working Certificate Test Rules & Regulations may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club (100 89 Skyway Avenue, Etobicoke, ON, M9W 6R4), or may be downloaded from https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations
- **Shotguns:** Handlers entered in the WCX stake may be required to handle a gun or a replica during the test. Gun safety is considered part of the test.
- Awards: All qualifying dogs will be awarded a rosette and trophy at the end of the test.

TEST LOCATION

Tests will be held at 1994 Wood Road, Wyebridge, Ontario. Please follow signs and directions of Test Marshalls.

Directions: "Hwy 400 North to Hwy 93 West through Hillsdale, Orr Lake and then Waverly. Stay on Hwy 93 to Ebenezer Side Road Turn Right onto Ebenezer Side Road to second Stop Sign (at Wood Road) Left turn onto Wood Road to Ebenezer Farm # 1994 on left side".

A service charge of 5% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online, by fax or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

Move-Ups: Dogs entered in and successfully completing the WC or WCI test may MOVE UP to the next test as long as the request is submitted in writing within 15 minutes after the ribbon presentation for the previous test. Requests must be made to Event Secretary, accompanied by additional entry fee in cash.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Telephone or emailed entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal disruption. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Be prepared: Bring adequate shade, sunscreen, water and cover for hot or wet weather for both you and your dog(s). Carry a first aid kit.

Training: No training is allowed on test grounds within 24 hours of the start of the test. (A bumper thrown by the handler for the purpose of a warm-up shall not be considered training).

Spectators: Spectators are welcome to watch these working dogs do what they were bred to do. Please wear dark or camouflage clothing and do not distract dogs or handers during the tests.

E-collars: No electronic collars on test grounds please.

Assistance: In the unlikely event that exhibitors and/or observers are requested to "chip-in" and assist in the execution of a test – please be willing to help the event run smoothly and efficiently. No previous experience required, just ensure you understand what is being requested!

Payment:

- Entries not accompanied by full payment cannot be accepted.
- \$US payments will be accepted at par.
- Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
- There will be an additional \$35.00 charge for N.S.F. cheques.
- Cheques and/or credit card payments cannot be accepted the day of the tests.

Refunds: No refunds will be given for scratches or withdrawals received after the closing date, except as stated in the CKC Working Certificate Test Rules & Regulations or referenced herein.

Entry Limit: 40 dogs

Non-Member Participation Fee: The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line. The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact CKC Head Office.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.
