Section A Proposed Amendment #2 Breed Standards



The CKC has written saying that Clubs and Breeders retain control of the standard

BUT

Section 25.4, Breed Standards STATES that

"the Board (CKC Board) shall have the authority to adopt new breed standards, and to amend any standards adopted by the Club". (text in bracket added for clarification)

As long as the bylaws read as per above then CKC ultimately HOLDS the right to change ANY and ALL standards as they see fit — NOT the Breed Club, Breeders OR Concerned Members.

Clubs over the past few years have been approached by the Breed Standards Committee to make changes to their standards. These clubs have followed the process outlined by CKC and their membership has declined the request of CKC. In a public forum the head of the Breed Standards Committee has declared that our standards will be changed regardless of our wishes.

SEVERAL BREEDS

As the current Bylaws Read—the CKC BOARD AND ONLY THE BOARD controls the standard. They have NOT followed the process they "outline". If they HAD we would NOT be having this discussion! The Proof is in the action—not the words!

Rules of Eligibility (ROE)



The CKC has written saying that The Animal Pedigre Act "Requires" the CKC to establish Rules of Eligibility" (ROE) for all the dogs it registers.



The Animal Pedigree Act already allows for our breed standard to be a description of the breed!
