When: **Saturday May 6th 2017**

Training: **9:00 am. to noon \$10 per dog at gate** Beginners only (Recommended if your dog has never been exposed to rats & tunnels. Space may be limited so contact Laurel to get on list.)

We invite all terriers & dachshunds and all feisty mixed breed dogs who can enter a 9" tunnel to participate in this training.

Test: **Introduction to Quarry at 1:00 pm. Fee \$5** (Dogs who do not complete IQ successfully will not be able to move up to JE. Dogs who complete IQ successfully may be moved up, under advisement of the IQ judge, to enter JE upon payment of an additional fee of \$5 at the registration desk.)

Junior Earthdog following IQ Fee \$10 followed by

Senior ED Fee \$10 followed by

Master ED Fee \$20

Space will be limited so please contact Laurel to get on the lists for each class.

Eligible Dogs for these tests are: all Group 4 Terriers and Miscellaneous Group Terriers, PRs and all Dachshunds able to enter a 9" tunnel.

Upon completion of the CKC Sanction Test, non-CKC dogs may be tested in the dens if time allows.
