JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of this Specialty

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

12 to 18 Months Class – This class shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>**MUST**</u> be the owner/co-owner <u>**AND**</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

VETERANS CLASS – This class shall be for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of this Specialty

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. <u>Note</u>: A Listed dog <u>MAY</u> be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class <u>MUST</u> be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FIRST SHOW. Listing Fees <u>WILL NOT</u> be refunded

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades
