## Introducing our judges

**Fred Basset** - I have been involved with show dogs for 55 years, since 1961. Pomeranians were my major focus while I was actively breeding and showing. In addition to Poms I have also owned and exhibited Poodles, Keeshonden, Old English Sheepdogs, Miniature Schnauzers, a Chihuahua, a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel, and an English Cocker Spaniel. We currently live with a Ragdoll Cat.

I was approved to judge Pomeranians in 1977, and have greatly enjoyed judging dogs for the past 39 years. I am currently approved for all Terrier, Toy, Non Sporting and Herding breeds; as well as Basset Hounds, Junior Showmanship, Miscellaneous Breeds, and Best in Show. I have judged all over the United States including many National Specialty shows, the Westminster Kennel Club and the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship. I have also judged a number of overseas assignments including Australia, Japan, South Korea, Mainland China, Taiwan, Europe, Mexico, South America and Canada.

I have been active in dog clubs from the early 1970's onward and have held virtually every office, and handled every role possible over the years. I am an honorary Life Member of the American Pomeranian Club, a member of the Mid-Continent Kennel Club of Tulsa, and two of the major judge's organizations in the USA. I have been active in mentoring and judges education for Pomeranians for many years, and have given seminars all over the United States, as well as overseas when I have judged. I conducted a week-long Judges Training program in Mainland China during 2014 as a Contractor for the American Kennel Club, utilizing a Translator and dual-language printed materials. I was appointed as Judges Education Coordinator for the American Pomeranian Club from 2008 to 2014.

My professional career was spent in the Information Technology / Data Processing field. I retired in March 2005 from a 32 year career in leadership roles working for American Airlines, Sabre Holdings and EDS.

I have been married to my wife Janet for 44 years. Janet is retired from a career as a Principal and teacher, and is now working for the Diocese of Tulsa as Assistant Superintendent. We have two grown Sons. Scott is 38 years old, married with one 10 year old Son, one 7 year old Son, and a darling 18 month old Son. He is an Aerospace Engineer. Todd is 34 years old, single and a Doctoral student at University of Missouri in Physical Therapy. I also have two "Sons by choice," Abraham & David Cruz. With them I started a clothing company called "Forever Faith" in 2010. This is a faith based, spiritually oriented company with a beautiful Lifestyle Philosophy, unlike any other clothing company today. **Stewart Dankner** - Stewart has been around purebred dogs all of his life. Family dogs included Standard Dachshunds, Irish Setters, mixed breeds and the Rhodesian Ridgeback. Together with his wife Jacquie, the Cedarpoint Kennel name was born and has produced many champions, specialty winners, coursing champions, tracking and hunting dogs. Stewart is a Conformation Judge with the Canadian Kennel Club and is working towards his all-breed status. Stewart has a particular interest in Canine Anesthesia and Canine Bleeding disorders.

Dogs are Stewart's passion and he presently sits as the Vice President of the Canadian Kennel Club Foundation. Outside of dogs, Stewart sits on the Board of the Canadian Coalition for Green Healthcare and is an advocate for Climate Change Resiliency, volunteers with various organizations for the sole purpose of philanthropy and he is currently working for a major healthcare organization. Stewart currently sits as president of a regional breed club, an executive member of a local all-breed club and actively participates in believes in rare breed shows.

**David R. Denis** - Our many years owned by dogs saw us as breeders of both Greater Swiss and Bernese Mountain Dogs with some of the offspring earning Specialty wins. Others did very well in drafting, obedience and rally. Entlebuchers, Saints, and Great Pyrs have also been part of our household. My judging career began in the seventies with lure coursing, and presently I am licensed to judge all levels of drafting, obedience, rally and lure coursing. I am also licensed to judge groups one, two and three while working on the last half of group seven. It has been my pleasure to judge in England, Scotland, Australia, Finland, and Denmark as well as often in the US.

**Honey Anne Glendinning** - I started my career in purebred show dogs in 1968 while still in high school. My breeds at that time were Irish and English Setters under the kennel name of Fantail, permanently registered. Several years later I stopped breeding Irish and continued on with only English Setters. My breeding program accomplished 6 Best in Show winners, multiple Specialty winners and in 1982 the Top Dog All Breed for Canada with 52 Best in Show including Best of Breed at the American and Canadian National Specialties and 6 Bests in Shows in the US. His name was Am Can Ch Fantail's Sunshine Man, and is now behind many of the top kennels around the world.

In 1982 I started judging. I became a Canadian All Breed judge in 1993, and in 2013 the Canadian Dog Judges Association awarded me my 20 year pin as an All Breed judge. I then challenged myself further and began going through the American Kennel Club system for judging. I so far have 3 Groups, breeds in 2 other Groups, Best in Show and Jr. Showmanship.

I have officiated at shows in 15 countries. I am a member of the English Setter Club of America, English Setter Club of Canada, Canadian Kennel Club, Canadian Dog Judges Association, Mount Rainier Working Dog Club, Oregon Dog Judges Club, American Dog Judges Club, and the Dog Judges Association.

**Shirley Hubenig** - Shirley has been involved in showing, breeding, training, trialing and teaching obedience for over 40 years. She began with Siberian Huskies and owned and trialed the first Utility titled Siberian Husky in Canada and bred and trained Sibes for 13 years. For the past 30 some years Dobermans have been her love, taking 4 to their Dual Championships. Her first Doberman was a multi BIS and BISS boy who was top obedience Doberman in Canada his first year out. During these years Shirley was also a handler showing over 20 different breeds to their championships.

Shirley now resides with an 8 yr. old Dobie boy who finished his championship as a Junior Puppy and went High in Trial at the Canadian Doberman National Specialty trial and completed all his Rally degrees in 3 weekends as well as Best Veteran at the Doberman National last year. Shirley was also the proud owner of a Standard Poodle who has now passed away and who completed her Championship as a Junior Puppy and her CD with 3 High in Classes and a High in Trial and achieved all her Rally degrees in less than one year.

Shirley has been Secretary/Treasurer for the Southern Alberta Judges Association for several years and is a CKC licensed obedience and rally judge as well as being licensed for Group 3, top 1/2 of Herding and on permit for the bottom half.

**Mirtha Mortera** - In 1972 she became interested in the world of dog shows through the Setter breeds: Irish, English and Gordon Setters. She co-founded, with her sister Marlene, Moroco Kennels, being recognized world-wide for their breeding in Gordon Setters. She has also owned various breeds such as Boxer, Siberian Husky, English Springer Spaniel, Pointer, Pomeranian, Shi Tzu, Samoyed and Afghan Hound.

Her Gordon Setters have been Best in Shows in various countries and in Gordon Setter Specialties in the USA. In Puerto Rico her dogs have been All Breed Dog of the Year. Ms Mortera also has been awarded Breeder of the Year on several occasions.

Ms Mortera has FCPR license to judge all breeds under FCI rules. She has been a member of The Gordon Setter Club of America, English Setter Association of America, Magnolia Gordon Setter Club, Caribe Kennel Club, Puerto Rico Boxer Club, German Shepherd Club of Puerto Rico, and Federacion Canofila de Puerto Rico, of which she has been on the Board of Directors for more than a decade.

She has judged in multiple dog shows and specialty dog shows in the USA, Puerto Rico, Dominican Republic, Mexico, Venezuela, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Canada, Guatemala, Colombia, Brazil, Peru, Honduras, El Salvador and the FCI World Show in 1997.

**Sharon Ann Redmer** - Sharon Redmer acquired her first Belgian Tervuren in 1971. She has judged Obedience for over 30 years. Sharon also judges Best in Show, the Herding Group, Poodles, 20 Working breeds, 1 Terrier and 10 Sporting Breed, Junior Showmanship and Rally.

In December, 2012, the American Kennel Club awarded Sharon the AKC Lifetime Achievement Award in Companion Events. Sharon is the only AKC judge to have officiated at all three AKC National Championships – Conformation, Obedience and Rally. She was honored to be Westminster Kennel Club's judge for its inaugural Obedience Championship competition in February 2016.

Sharon has judged many dog shows on 4 continents. In 2014 she was honored to be the first American conformation judge ever to officiate at the French National Specialty show for Belgian Shepherd Dogs – "the show" for Belgians worldwide. She has proudly judged breed at both the US and Canadian National Specialties for the Belgians multiple times.

Sharon and her husband Edward have bred multitalented Tervuren for 40 years under the "StarBright" affix. Over 125 Champions have been finished – many are also Obedience Trial Champions or Herding Trial Champions or Tracking Champions, High in Trial winners, BIS or Group awardees or National Specialty Breed winners.

Sharon holds a Masters in Nursing and recently retired after a successful career in health care administration at the University of Michigan. The Redmers live near Ann Arbor, MI with their five Tervs and one very bossy cat.

**Jacqueline Rusby** – Jacqueline has been judging for 25 years, 23 years licensed, and judges all breeds. She is a Life Member of the Canadian Kennel Club- a member & former Treasurer of the Canadian Dog Judges Association, a past President of the Hochelaga Kennel Club & Mount Royal Toy Dog Fanciers, past Conformation Director of the Ottawa Valley Poodle Club. She is also a member of the American Dog Judges' Institute. She is a former breeder of all varieties of Poodles. In earlier years she also participated in Obedience Trials as well as Conformation Shows. Her travels now take her for judging in Argentina, Australia, Bahamas, Canada, Chile, Columbia, Denmark, Mexico, New Zealand, South Africa, Thailand and USA.

**Dale Simmons** - Dale Simmons is now a retired university professor who has been involved with purebred dogs since a teenager. He has been an exhibitor, breeder, club official, show chairman, steward, judge education program coordinator, and conformation judge. He has been invited to judge in the majority of US States, New Zealand, Australia, Taiwan, China, and Canada. Now approved to judge 5 American Kennel Club groups as well as some breeds in the other groups, the Whippet was the first breed he was approved to judge. The breeds he has exhibited/owned include the Cocker Spaniel, Whippet, Belgian Malinois, and Norwegian Lundehund.

**Lee Steeves** – Terriers and Sporting Dogs have been in my family all of my life. Among us, we owned Smooth Fox, an Airedale, a Miniature Schnauzer, a kennel of Springer Spaniels and Weimaraners and one great Beagle! With the addition of a Great Dane and a small Buick as a University graduation gift, my Dad pointed out to me that marriage need not come too quickly. Many years later, I met and married my great husband whose family too had dogs including Rover the tree climbing Newfoundland around whom legends have been built and – an Airedale. It was not a stretch for us to add terriers to our life and to establish Regalridge Kennel in the early 1980's. Currently we live with several Airedales and Welsh Terriers as well as one cherished Cirneco. It seems no life is complete without a Hound.

Airedales and later Welsh Terriers are the cornerstones of our breeding program, with Norwich added for comic relief. Regalridge has been a highly successful kennel in Canada and the US with one or another of our dogs appearing in the top five of their breeds for most of the past three decades. It is also a prefix that can be found behind many of the top winning Airedales in the US and other countries throughout the world.

We have been active in dog related clubs and associations, serving repeatedly on the Executive of our Regional Terrier Association, the National Breed Club for Welsh Terriers, our local all breed Club and ultimately as Chair of the Board of the Canadian Kennel Club.

From a professional perspective, I am 'retired' from Senior Management in the Federal Public Service. After 'retiring', Ken and I became active in community affairs, having moved to rural Nova Scotia (15 minutes from Halifax airport). I have chaired the County's Regional Economic Development Board, the Board of the CAP Committee and have developed and offered Community based Seniors Computer Skills training program, training over 100 Seniors in computer use. I am a professional writer and served on the Board of Pets Atlantic magazine as well as a part-time Communications Consultant in the areas of government and private sector strategic planning, policy and training.

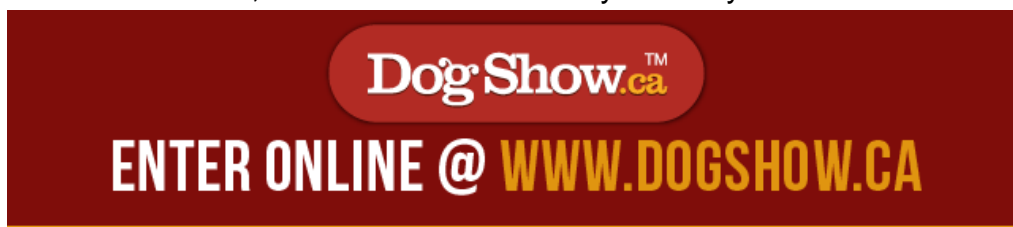

Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.**

## CLASSIFICATION

Please see CKC rule books for specific class descriptions. These rules may be viewed on the CKC website (<https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Conformation-Show-Rules-and-Regulations.aspx>). It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the Conformation, Obedience & Rally rules as set out by the Canadian Kennel Club

## CONFORMATION

The following CKC conformation classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

**Junior Puppy:** for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age.

**Senior Puppy:** for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age

**12-18 Months:** for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age

**Canadian Bred:** for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded.

**Bred by Exhibitor:** for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

**Open:** for all dogs.

**Specials Only:** dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and have attained championship status may be entered in the 'Specials Only' class. **Exhibition Only:** for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (non-competitive class).

**Veterans:** offered Saturday, Sunday only. Veterans will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed judged for each. The Best of Breed winner will go on to Best Veteran in Group and Best Veteran in Show. Dogs must be 7 years or older on the day of the show.

**Baby Puppy (3-6 Months):** offered Friday, Saturday, Sunday only. For dogs 3 months of age & under 6 months of age – dogs will compete in this unofficial class for Best Male/Best Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Group & Show. They do not compete for Winners.

**Altered:** offered Saturday and Sunday only - dogs for the altered classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure. Altered dogs must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition only to be eligible to compete.

## OBEDIENCE

**Pre-Novice:** for any pure bred dog that has not earned the title PCD (Pre Companion Dog) title in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A dog may be entered in this class that has not earned the title of CD in Canada or US.

**Novice A:** for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for this class.

**Novice B:** for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class.

**Novice C:** for any purebred dog that has gained a CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced title and exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice classes. Scores earned in Novice C are not eligible for High in Trial. This is an elective class and offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience. Dogs may be entered in Novice C class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial classes.

**Novice Intermediate:** For any dog that has earned a CD or higher obedience title. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are NOT eligible for High in Trial.

**Open A:** for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

**Open B:** for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD, CDX or UD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class. A dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog eligible for UD is also eligible for entry in this class at the same trial.

**Utility A:** for any purebred dog that has won the title of CDX in CANADA. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'group examination' exercise.

**Utility B:** for any purebred dog and handler where the dog has achieved a CDEX and a UD title and for dogs and handlers where the handler has put a MOTCH title on any dog.

## RALLY

**Rally Novice A:** Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

**Rally Novice B:** Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. No dog may be entered in Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

**Rally Intermediate:** For dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RI or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. Dog handled by owner or any other person.

**Rally Advanced A:** For dogs that have won the Rally Novice title but have not won the Rally Advanced title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

**Rally Advanced B:** For dogs that have won the Rally Novice title no dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

**Rally Excellent A:** for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced title but have not won the Rally Excellent title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

**Rally Excellent B:** for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced title. No dog may be entered in the Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B class at the same show.

In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association and associated Specialty Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

**Section 15.1.12**

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an *Event Registration Number* or a *Miscellaneous Certification Number*.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
