
East from Vancouver, Hwy 1 take exit 116 (Lickman Road)

UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES:

All dogs entered the Unofficial Class must also be entered in one of the Official Classes or for exhibition only on the same day.

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u>- This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class". Dogs entered in the Veterans Class may also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only. ½ (one half) point will be added for each year of age.

TRANSITION OBEDIENCE CLASSES:

<u>PRE-NOVICE</u> – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other

country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE – This class shall be for purebred dogs of any breed and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous class breeds and of either sex that have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog and any other advanced obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice C and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to

advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes

Veteran Sweeps

This Sweepstakes class is open to all Boxers seven years of age or over on the day of the specialty, regardless of their place of birth. All dogs entered, must also be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only at this Specialty Show. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete. The first place dog from each class will be brought together to compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner up in Sweepstakes. Classes (divided by sex) will be as follows:

7 & 8 years Male/Female - 9 &10 years Male/Female - 11 years and over Male/Female

A rosette will be given to the OLDEST Veteran.

Juvenile Sweeps

This Sweepstakes class is open to all Boxers from 6 months to under 18 months regardless of their place of birth. All dogs MUST also be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only. The first place dog from each class will be brought together to compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner up in Sweepstakes. Classes (divided by sex) will be as follows:

6-9 months Male/Female 12-15 month M/F

9-12 month Male/Female 15-18 month M/F

Breeder Sweeps

Open to all Breeder-handled dogs, but need not be owned by the breeder. All dogs must be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only in this Specialty Show. The first place dog from each class will be brought together to compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner up in Sweepstakes. Classes (divided by sex) will be as follows:

Junior Puppy/Senior Puppy/12-15 month/15-18 month /Open/Specials

Prizes:

Best in Sweepstakes - 30% of total entry fees collected and rosette

Runner up in Sweepstakes - 20% of total entry fees collected and rosette

1st in class - 25% of <u>class</u> fees collected and double satin ribbon (Veterans – Rosette)

2nd - 4th in each class - double satin ribbon (Veterans – Rosette)

Balance of 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs.

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

<u>NOVICE "A"</u> - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES**. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS**

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

<u>OPEN "A"</u> - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. **One dog ONLY** may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor *MUST BE THE OWNER* or *A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY* and *MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES*. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but *MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN* "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>OPEN "B"</u> - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS**. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'A'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'B'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES (divided by sex):

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

<u>12 TO 15 MONTHS</u> - Shall be for dogs 12 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

<u>15 TO 18 MONTHS</u> - Shall be for dogs 15 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Specialty

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

<u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS (Fawn) - This class shall be for all dogs

OPEN CLASS (Brindle) - This class shall be for all dogs

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u>: Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will NOT compete for Championship points but goes directly into the Best of Breed competition. SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

ALTERED CLASSES:

Shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class will be judged upon completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes only will be offered as follows: Altered Male and Altered Female Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each class will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed & Best Opposite Altered.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Auld Lang Syne Dog Association & Renaissance Dog Association, their members, directors, governors. officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
