

**EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (for Foreign Exhibitors)**  
 Effective January 1, 1994, the cost to obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN) has been increased to \$50.00. This is necessary due to a new tax imposed by the Federal Government - the Goods and Services Tax (GST). To obtain an ERN number simply do the following: - Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number. Include a cheque, money order or credit card authorization for the full amount. Please do not send discounted cheques or money orders. Credit card authorizations will be processed in Canadian dollars; personal cheques or money orders must be for \$50.00 U.S. dollars unless drawn on a Canadian bank in which case the amount may be in Canadian dollars. Provide your full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure your Visa or MasterCard number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature personal cheques or money orders must be for \$50.00 U.S. dollars unless drawn on a Canadian bank in which case the amount may be in Canadian dollars.. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. **CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

Section 1: A dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these Dog Show rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5), and the determinations of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.  
 Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\* includes the dog awarded Winners.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners total all the dogs in the competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of breed, or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

## SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Entry fees will not be refunded after closing date in the event dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the vet or judge, or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is not possible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
2. Entries will be acknowledged as soon as possible after the closing date of the show. Receipts, judging schedules and exhibitors passes will be mailed.
3. All dogs must be kept under complete control at all times. No dogs allowed in the Show building unless entered in the shows.
4. Dogs are to be exercised only in designated areas. The city of Swift Current has a by-law that requires all dogs to be leashed when outside.
5. Washing of dogs in our washroom basins is strictly prohibited.
6. A judge officiating at a show held under Dog Show Rules shall not be subjected to indignation of any kind, during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement to the rule, and the Board of Directors shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
7. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor or handler to have dogs at ringside when required for judging. Handlers are to report any absentees and to have assistants at ringside if they are engaged elsewhere. Exhibitors should remain at ringside until the judging of the breed is complete.
8. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
9. As defined by the SWSK&OC the Show Precincts includes show rings and the grooming area in the Stockade building.

## JUNIOR HANDLING

This event will be held on Saturday after Best in Shows are done. Entry fee - \$2.00. All dogs handled in this competition must be entered in one of the official classes on the day of the event. The following will be provided:

**Pee Wee - Ages 4-6 (non competitive)**

**Junior Novice - Age 7 to 10 inclusive who have not won six firsts with competition.**

**Junior Open - Age 7 to 10 inclusive (have won 6 firsts with competition)**

**Intermediate Novice - Ages 11-14 who have not won six first in the same class with competition.**

**Intermediate Open - Ages 11-14 who have won six firsts in the same class with competition.**

**Senior Novice - Ages 15 to 18 inclusive who have not won six first in the same class with competition.**

**Senior Open - Ages 15 to 18 who have won six first placements in the same class.**

Rosettes will be awarded for first placement in each class and Best Junior Handler Overall, as designated by the C.K.C.

Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.**

Tendering an N.S.F. cheque shall be considered NON-PAYMENT OF ENTRY and is punishable by disciplinary action & cancel of awards by the CKC. There is a \$30.00 charge for NSF cheques and invalid or declined credit cards.

Entries must be signed by the owner or agent or the entry will be rejected.
