ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an **ERN** - **Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$55.85 plus 13% Ontario HST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

• Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs <u>owned and handled in the ring</u> by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
Open	for all dogs.
Veteran	for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED .
Specials Only	for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.

Exhibition Only	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in <u>Exhibition Only 3-6 Months</u> provided <u>3-6 months</u> the Owner has also entered an eligible dog in a Regular Class . <u>These</u> <u>Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular classes or Parades</u> .
