The following classes will be offered in each of the four trials: Regular, Selected and Veterans: Standard, Points and Distance (PAD), Jumpers with Weaves and Steeplechase.

Levels - Novice - is open to dogs that have not aquired an Intermediate leg in the class entered.

Intermediate - class is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title in the class entered.

Excellent - class is for dogs that have aquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned a qualifying score towards the Excellent title in the class entered.

Master Excellent - class is for dogs that have aquired the Agility Excellent title in the class entered.

PAD - involves a point gathering component and distance element within a 35 second time frame.

Steeplechase - a fast pace course designed to test the dog's ability to negotiate a jumpers style course while performing the A Frame and weave poles. Please note that Steeplechase is all one level.

There will be 1 ring with the Trials alternating, for example: Trial 1 Standard, Trial 2 Standard, Trial 1 PAD, Trial 2 PAD etc. Saturday's events will run within the classes as "Tall to Small" while Sunday's events will run "Small to Tall". These trials will be held outdoors on a grass surface.

Entry Fees: \$20 per run or our Special Weekend rate of \$280 for the same dog entered in all 16 runs in the 4 trials, or our Volunteer rate (limited to the first 20 per trial who sign up with their entry), you agree to help a minimum of 3 times per trial as assigned by the agility chair at a special volunteer rate of \$60. for 4 runs/same dog/per trial.

Height Divisions

Handlers are responsible for entering the correct height division. The judge may request any dog be measured. Selected class dogs will jump one height lower than the equivalent regular class height as shown below. Dogs who measure 10" or below will jump 4" in the Selected Class. Veteran dogs may jump one or two heights lower. The following jump height divisions shall be used in all regular classes.

8 inches for dogs 10" and under at the withers 12 inches for dogs 14" and under at the withers 16 inches for dogs 18" and under at the withers 20 inches for dogs 22" and under at the withers 24 inches for dogs over 22" inches at the withers

Obstacles - agility obstacles meet the requirements of the CKC Agility Rules. **Electronic timing** will be used at these trials.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 – A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. (15.1.2)

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also places in the GROUP as listed below.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and, (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13).

Best Puppy in Breed Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed is NOT required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the **owner or handler**.

Effective January, 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees, however, WILL NOT be refunded. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)
