Being a tracklayer gives you a judge's perspective on plotting and judging exhibitors! When it is your turn to enter a test – you take that knowledge with you.

The **Stinky Feet Seminar** will give you that same information! Work with Donna Brinkworth, approved CKC Tracking Judge – all levels, on field and urban tracks. Then have fun running your dog on the track you helped to plot! Or "judge" dogs that run tracks you helped to plot!



**Having stinky feet is very rewarding.** You get to see the joy on tracker's faces as they pass to earn a new tracking title! If this sounds like a fun way to spend a day, bring your STINKY FEET to the seminar.
