Kiersten Lloyd is from Edmonton, AB and has been training and competing in Obedience and Agility since 1994 and has taught Obedience and Agility since 1997. She has had 8 dogs over her career. Her and her dogs have had some success over the years. In Obedience, Kes was the top Labrador for 5 years and in the Top 10 All Breed in Canada 1999 and 2000. She was the first dog in Alberta to earn her MOTCh. Her dogs have also earned multiple High in Trial and High Aggregate awards. Between her earlier dogs they earned 4 CD titles, 4 CDX titles, 2 OTCh and 1 MOTCh titles.

She then discovered Agility and the challenge, variation and speed grabbed her attention and has never let go. In Agility her dogs have earned many awards and acknowledgements. Kes won the AAC National Championships in 2003 and 2005. She finished in the top 9 for all the AAC National events until 2007. She was in the Top 3 for all but 2001. She earned her Lifetime Award as was only a few runs from her second Lifetime award when she retired.

Zoom has earned her AAC Lifetime Award, her Grand Masters Title in CKC, her MAD and Bronze Tournament title in USDAA. She has also run in AKC and UKI events. She won the 26" Division at the 2008 AAC National Championships. She competed at 4 Cynosport World games in the USA. In 2009 they also competed for Canada at the FCU World Championships in Dornbern, Austria and placed 18th out of 87 dogs in her Standard run.

Swift placed 6th in the 26" Division at the 2010 AAC Nationals. She has her Silver Award of Merit in AAC, and has titles in CKC and runs in USDAA, UKI and AKC events.

Furai is her newest dog and runs AAC, AKC and UKI.

Kiersten is not all about titles. She looks at titles as markers of the wonderful relationship she has with her dogs. She thinks that all those who want to compete with their dogs in any event need to endeavor to understand their dogs and understand what they are capable of. While she is all for pushing our dogs to be their best she thinks it is very important to realize their limits. To end here is a quote from Kiersten "We have to enjoy the process of training and learning about our dogs. If we don't then why play."
