GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES:

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules Pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Draft Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club

As per the Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations, the group option as stated in Section 11.2, is not offered at this test. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching the Test Secretary after the official closing date as published in the premium list or after the maximum number of entries has been received.

No Entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. Incomplete entries will be returned. No Entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. **Telephone, fax and E-mail entries cannot be accepted.**

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Cancellations of any entry after the closing day are prohibited. The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules. Identification and judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after **entries close**.

ACCOMMODATION:

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all purebred CKC recognized breed dogs Eighteen months of age or older on the day of the event. Every Dog Entered must be one of the following: Registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration Number (ERN); eligible for registration with the CKC have a Performance Event Number (PEN), have a Canine Companion Number (CNN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN). Entries in the Draft Dog Excellent Test must have a CKC Draft Dog (DD)

Entries in the Draft Dog Excellent Test must have a CKC Draft Dog (DD) Title. Entries in the Brace Draft Dog Excellent Test must have a CKC Brace Draft Dog (BDD) Title. The Judges must excuse a dog at any time during a Test for lack of physical capacity.

ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, signed & submitted on the official CKC entry form. The order of competing shall be the order that entries are received except that dogs handled by the same person will be separated when possible. No delays will be permitted for handlers entering more than one dog and entrants doing so must have

an alternate handler available for the group down exercise if a conflict arises. Re-qualifications will be accepted pending space available. Requalifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered. After the closing date, mail, email, fax and/or telephone of their entry will notify all entries.

<u>BITCHES IN SEASON</u>: Bitches in season are allowed to compete but all exercises will be judged after all other dogs have been tested. Bitches in season must be kept away from the test site prior to testing.

EQUIPMENT: Each entrant to supply his or her own equipment and apparatus. The test committee will supply the freight load. DDX Entrants must provide their own backpacks and backpack weight.

TEST REGULATIONS: All dogs most complete and pass all exercises in the Draft Dog, Draft Dog Excellent test, to be award the title.

NON-MEMBER: Non CKC Member Participation Fee - Canadian Residents Only As of April, 2011: the CKC has instituted a Non-Member Participation fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event, but are not CKC members. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the nonmember will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members resident in Canada, and does not apply to U.S. exhibitors nor to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.
