Denise Hanlon (Wales), Bekwey Border Collies - Dog owner, breeder, trainer and exhibitor of German Shepherds and Border Collies and competitive obedience with Shelties and Border collies, under the kennel names of Maidenhatch and Bekwey since 1967. I have a keen interest in keeping up with modern methods and a deep rooted love for and understanding of the Border Collie and all the breed is about. Now retired from obedience and any judging, I still do conformation shows and some sheep work when I can.

Heather Turner (Scotland), Locheil Border Collies I've been involved with dogs since a child. I come from a farming background and have been competing, first in obedience and then in conformation since the late 70's. I have run dogs at sheepdog trials and bred and trained the breed's first Full Champion, Locheil Look North. I've been breeding since 1987, and have bred a number of UK show champions and many champions abroad. I award CCs in the UK and have judged abroad a fair amount including the first Australian Border Collie National in 2006. I get tremendous pleasure from breeding and also training my dogs to try to get the best from them.

This clinic is designed for handlers and their dog; working towards getting the best from your dog and its movement which as we know is unique to the breed. We do not come with the aim of judging individual dogs, but instead to help you get the best out of each and every one. It is not easy in the show ring to produce the natural movement we see when our dogs work sheep, but with understanding and training we can achieve the breed typical, positive gait required. The first day will see us talking about the need for correct construction related to movement, and then the rest of the two days will be purely practical. Heather will take the big ring and will work with you individually on pace, stacking, ring techniques etc tailored to your own dog. Denise will take out anyone with any specific issues, puppies, etc and work using strictly force free positive training methods (some you may never have seen before), and will leave you with "homework" to work on for the future. The theory behind all methods will be explained as we go along, and we look forward to a lively, informative and educational weekend...none of us ever stop learning! We will always be available for back up and advice in the future as well.

The cost of this clinic will be \$200 per person for the weekend. It will include the instruction noted above, as well as a BBQ dinner on the Saturday night. This is a "first of its kind" opportunity in our country, and a fantastic learning opportunity for both those exhibiting and judging border collies. All CKC, AKC and UKC licensed and permit judges are invited to attend this event free of charge and learn from some the UK's leading Border Collie experts on how this unique breed should be presented in the show ring.
