Section 3.4.1 “Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.”

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Vernon & District Kennel Club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

Rates **start at \$25.00 per night**. Vehicles will be assigned sites according to size. Trees on a site are not guaranteed – if you want one, please bring your own. (See our tree contest!) A shade tent is highly recommended.

**Ringside level** parking is restricted to exhibitors with **5 or more dogs ENTERED** in the shows. Due to new bylaws initiated by the area Fire Chief, the club has made parking site adjustments – they are larger! It does result in fewer parking spaces so **PLEASE BOOK EARLY** and give accurate dimensions of your unit! **A \$20.00 damage deposit is required at time of booking.** (This will be refunded at departure – unless you leave a mess or damage!)

**Grounds will open at 12:00 noon on Thursday July 6<sup>th</sup>**

\$20 cash deposit will be required upon arrival.

***NO early birds please as we will be setting up!***

To facilitate the Fire Marshall rules, all units must be parked in the CENTER of the site. ALL exhaust fumes and/or generator fumes MUST be exhausted to the front, rear or above roof level by way of an extension pipe. Units that cannot exhaust this way will NOT BE ALLOWED TO USE THEIR GENERATORS.

**! Please ensure your generator is in good working order - if we receive a complaint of excessive fumes or noise you may be asked to move your unit !**

To avoid damage to the grounds by unit jacks, generators, exhaust pipes and barbeques you must have a board to put under your system to protect the grass.

*Units without boards will not be allowed to park on the grounds. Boards will be available at the gate for a small "donation" (\$2.00) to the Club's Junior Kennel Club.*

- Please ensure units are filled with fresh water and gray water tanks are flushed PRIOR to entering the grounds. **THERE ARE NO FILL OR DUMPING FACILITIES AVAILABLE ON THE GROUNDS.**
- In an ongoing effort to protect the grounds from damage (and ensure continued use of the park!) the Club will restrict driving in and out of the park during the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm daily.
- There will be only one designated vehicle (or van & trailer unit) per site. Daily Exhibitors who plan on setting up with friends at an overnight site will be asked to park outside the gate and "dolly" their equipment and dogs onto the grounds.
- There will be NO TRAFFIC ALLOWED on the lower level near the rings during show hours!
- Campers with extra vehicles MUST park them outside the fence. Exhibitors using an assigned over-night camping spot will be charged the camping fee per night charge even if their vehicle is not parked there overnight. Exhibitors using these sites are asked to be on-site by 0800 and not to leave until after BIS.
- Generators may ONLY be run between the hours of 6:00am and 10:00pm - NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!
- Washrooms, playground, showers at the pool. (Note: the showers are OUTDOORS AT THE POOL - please bring a swimsuit!) Showers are open 6-8am and usually 10am to 7pm (pool hours)
- Concession will be open daily. Gates will be closed at 11:00pm each night.
- All exhibitors and vendors MUST clear the grounds within TWO (2) HOURS after Best Puppy in Show on Sunday.



### CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

<b>DOGS COMPETING*</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3 to 5</b>	<b>6 to 9</b>	<b>10 to 12</b>	<b>13 or more</b>

\*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below;

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

### **CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB Non Member Participation Fee (April 2011)**

ERN number: All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at: (416) 675 5511 or Fax (416) 675 6506

### **CKC Non-Member Participation Fee - (24-12-3)**

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

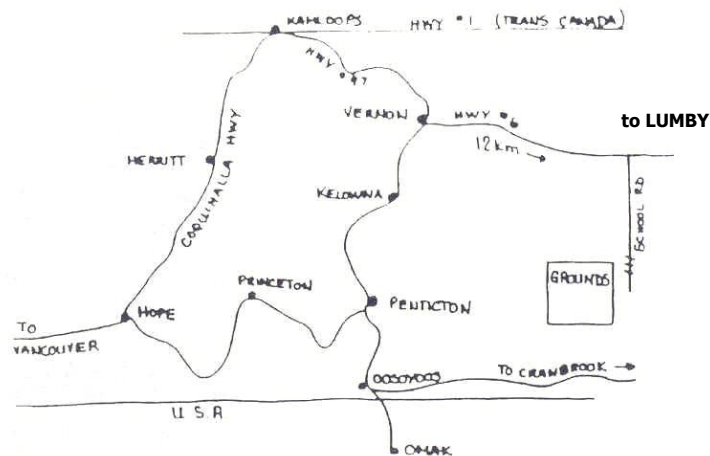

Friday, July 7<sup>th</sup> 2016 is held in conjunction with the Vernon and District Kennel Club show in Lavington, (east of Vernon) at the Community Park on School Road.

**8:30 AM to 5:00 PM. (Clinic is on the show grounds). The cost per examination is a flat cost of \$50.00 if you pre-register using this form. If you book an appointment at the show, the cost is \$55.00. If you pre-register and decide not to have the test done, there will be a charge of \$5.00 to cover pre-exam form completion. NO dogs will be examined until fees have been paid.** Payment by Mastercard or VISA will be available on the day of exam for an additional \$5 fee.

Remember that drops will have to be administered 20-30 minutes before the exam. These drops stay in effect for approximately 2 hours. They make your dogs eyes light sensitive. This could affect your dog's prime capabilities to show his/her best.

## GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

1. Entries **MUST BE** typed or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for any errors on their entry forms. The Club does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors submitted on any entry form by either owner or agent, nor for the incorrect entry of a dog in a class for which it is not eligible.
2. All entries must be received by the Show Secretary at the time of closing. The postmark will not make an entry acceptable if it is received after the closing date.
3. Exhibitors may withdraw their entries any time up to the closing date for a full refund. If withdrawn by telephone, written confirmation **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary no later than 7 days after the closing date. (See CKC Rules Ch.13 Sec.6.1). Entry fees **WILL NOT** be refunded after the closing date.
4. Entry fees **WILL** be refunded if a female entered in Obedience comes into season after the closing date, provided a letter from a Veterinarian indicates that the female is in season within a 10 day period prior to the trial. This letter **MUST** be submitted to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
5. N.S.F. CHEQUES for parking, barbeques, etc, will bar the exhibitor from entering future shows/trials held by the club in question.

### RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING THESE SHOWS/TRIALS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the shows/trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or other misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors or patrons.
3. Exhibitors/handlers are solely responsible for the conduct and actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds and for their equipment left at the show grounds.
4. If because of riot, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, **NO REFUND** of entry will be made.
5. Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour before the judging of their breeds and may be removed when not required for further judging.
6. Dogs must be on leashes at all times on the show grounds.
7. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club will not be responsible for and are not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring will be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.
8. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog **BEFORE** going to judging rings.
9. All trailer, recreational units and campers **MUST** have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed from the parking areas, by order of the Health Department.
10. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the premises for the duration of the shows.
11. Matting must be used in exercise pens to prevent dogs from digging holes in the grass.
12. The precincts of these shows and trials will be within a 50 foot perimeter of all rings

## EXTRACTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

### CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

### 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

#### Section 3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

(a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed

(b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration

(c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$8.92 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

#### Section 2.3:

##### INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being canceled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

#### Section 8.2:

##### DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

### CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

#### Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules

### CHAPTER 9 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

## NEW CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2006

8.2.5 – An error in the class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show.

8.5.8 – In the case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes within the show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition (armband) number. A new entry, along with accompanying entry fees and listing fees (if applicable), will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the opening of the show (see section 8.5.4)

8.9.3 – When one or more all-breed and/or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the all-breed or Specialty show.

12.3.1 – A Puppy awarded Best Puppy in Group is NOT required to stay for Best Puppy in Show.

### CONFORMATION CLASSES

*The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered*

**JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS** - for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

**SENIOR PUPPY CLASS** for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

**12 to 18 MONTH CLASS**- for any dog 12 months but under 18 months of age on the day of the show

**CANADIAN BRED CLASS** - for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS** - for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler **must** be the owner/co-owner **and** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

**OPEN CLASS** - for all dogs

**SPECIALS ONLY CLASS** - for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status.

**Note:** A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **may not compete** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

**ALL DOGS ENTERED IN AN UNOFFICIAL CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY**

**BABY PUPPY** - for a dog 3 months up to 6 months on the day of the show

**BRACE** - This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in the premium list

### OBEDIENCE CLASSES

**\*No dog may be entered in both Novice "A" & Novice "B" at the same trial.**

**\*No dog may be entered in both Open "A" & Open "B" at the same trial.**

**PRE-NOVICE** – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

**NOVICE "A"** - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE NOVICE "B" CLASS**

**NOVICE "B"** - This class is open to all dogs which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

**NOVICE "C"** – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**OPEN "A"** - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor ***MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY*** and ***MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.*** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

**OPEN "B"** - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog ***MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS.*** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

**UTILITY CLASS 'A'** - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

**UTILITY CLASS 'B'** - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. prior to the start of the class.

### **UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES**

***(These classes are available Friday & Saturday ONLY)***

***ALL DOGS ENTERED IN AN UNOFFICIAL CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY***

**BRACE CLASS** - This Class is open to any two dogs of the breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a 'CD' title in Canada. Same person need not own both dogs.

**VETERANS CLASS** - This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the 'Novice Class'.

**GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS** - This class is open to all dogs that have not gained a qualifying score toward the 'CDX' title in Canada BUT that has obtained the title 'CD' in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

**GRADUATE OPEN CLASS** - is open to any dog that has not earned a qualifying score toward the UD title, but which has obtained the title of 'CDX' prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises.

### **RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS**

***NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL.  
NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT SAME TRIAL***

**RALLY NOVICE A:** Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

**RALLY NOVICE B:** Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY NOVICE INTERMEDIATE:** This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

**RALLY ADVANCED A:** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

**RALLY ADVANCED B:** This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY EXCELLENT A:** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

**RALLY EXCELLENT B:** This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
