

Please ensure units are filled with fresh water and gray water tanks are flushed PRIOR to entering the grounds. THERE ARE NO FILL OR DUMPING FACILITIES AVAILABLE ON THE GROUNDS.

In an ongoing effort to protect the grounds from damage (and ensure continued use of the park!) the Club will restrict driving in and out of the park during the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm daily. There will be only one designated vehicle (or van & trailer unit) per site. Daily Exhibitors who plan on setting up with friends at an overnight site will be asked to park outside the gate and "dolly" their equipment and dogs onto the grounds. THERE WILL BE NO TRAFFIC ALLOWED ON THE LOWER LEVEL NEAR THE RINGS **DURING SHOW HOURS.**

Campers with extra vehicles MUST park them outside the fence. Exhibitors using an assigned over-night camping spot will be charged the camping fee per night charge even if their vehicle is not parked there overnight. Exhibitors using these sites are asked to be on-site by 0800 and not to leave until after BIS.

Generators may only be run between the hours of 7:00am and 10:00pm - NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!

Washrooms, playground, showers at the pool. (Note: the showers are OUTDOORS AT THE POOL - please bring a swimsuit!) Concession will be open daily. Gates will be closed at 11:00pm each night.

(This will be refunded at departure – unless you leave a mess or damage!)

Grounds will open at 12:00 noon on Thursday July 4th – no early birds please as we will be setting up!

All units will be parked door side to wall side unless door to door parking is mutually agreed to with your neighbour. The Vernon & District Kennel Club would have been proud to have Mr James Campbell exercise his power as a judge granted emeritus status by the CKC. Mr Campbell was originally approved by CKC to judge Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show and Best reeder/Owner/Handler in Show on Friday, July 5th, 2013. Mr Campbell's history with the club dates back to it's earliest shows so it was to have been most fitting that he judge at our 50th Anniversary Shows & Trials. However CKC rescinded the approval on March 11, 2013 stating:

"THAT, James Malcolm Campbell be permitted to judge one best in show per vear under his Emeritus status".

Mr. Campbell, in accordance with this motion you can do one Best in Show per year, however I would like to remind you with respect to section 5.1.7 of the Conformation rules: "No person may act as a show official (Show Superintendent, Show Secretary, Chief Ring Steward, Ring Steward) while he or any member of his immediate family is acting as an officiating judge at the same show...."

Your immediate family member, Kim Campbell, is the show secretary for the club at which you will be officiating. If you judge at this show, she cannot be the show secretary. Alternatively, she can be the show secretary but you cannot judge at this same show.

As a result of this error in the approval made by CKC Shows & Trials, Ms Susan Quesnel will judge Best in Show on the first day of shows – Friday July 5, 2013 in place of Mr James M Campbell (emeritus judge)

Daily assignments are noted on the following page

GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

- 1.Entries <u>MUST BE</u> typed or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for any errors on their entry forms. The Club does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors submitted on any entry form by either owner or agent, nor for the incorrect entry of a dog in a class for which it is not eligible.
- 2.All entries must be received by the Show Secretary at the time of closing. The postmark will not make an entry acceptable if it is received after the closing date. 3.Exhibitors may withdraw their entries any time up to the closing date for a full refund. If withdrawn by telephone, written confirmation MUST be received by the Show Secretary no later than 7 days after the closing date. (See CKC Rules Ch.13 Sec.6.1). Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded after the closing date.
- 4.Entry fees WILL be refunded if a female entered in Obedience comes into season after the closing date, provided a letter from a Veterinarian indicates that the female is in season within a 10 day period prior to the trial. This letter MUST be submitted to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- 5.N.S.F. CHEQUES for parking, barbeques etc, will bar the exhibitor from entering future shows/trials held by the club in question.

RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING THESE SHOWS/TRIALS

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the shows/trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or other misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. Exhibitors/handlers are solely responsible for the conduct and actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds and for their equipment left at the show grounds.
- 4. If because of riot, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, NO REFUND of entry will be made.
- 5. Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour before the judging of their breeds and may be removed when not required for further judging.
- 6. Dogs must be on leashes at all times on the show grounds.
- 7. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and are not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring will be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.
- 8. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE going to judging rings.
- 9. All trailer, recreational units and campers MUST have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed from the parking areas, by order of the Health Department.
- 10. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the premises for the duration of the shows.
- 11. Matting must be used in exercise pens to prevent dogs from digging holes in the grass.
- 12. The precincts of these shows and trials will be within a 50 foot perimeter of all rings

ON-SITE CLINICS

CERF Clinic will be held on Friday, July 5th starting at 8:30 am. Dr Graham Lewis will be on site to conduct the eye tests. Cost is \$50.00 per dog (HST included) if you pre-register & \$55.00 at the show. If you pre-register and do not test your dog, there will be a \$5.00 charge for the prepared paperwork. Dogs DO NOT have to be entered in the show to attend the Eye Clinic. Advise the Gate Attendants and they will direct you to drive to the CERF parking area. You MUST leave the grounds immediately after your CERF tests are completed. You are welcome to park outside the grounds and return to watch the show but dogs not entered in the shows & trials are NOT allowed on the grounds so please take the heat of the day into account when leaving your dogs in a vehicle. CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more POINTS AWARDED 0 1 2 3 4 5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below;

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

GRAND CHAMPION

(synopsis only – full details posted on CKC website Points towards a Grand Championship cannot be gained until a dog completes its Canadian Championship. The accumulation of points began January 1, 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms are available for download from

the CKC website and it is the responsibility of the owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit the form to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2-2 point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships. A judge will select Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch (the latter 2 will be chosen from the remaining Specials dogs competing, if any in competition). The points are based on the total number of dogs defeated

Day Parking Instructions

- Day Parking is ONLY PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE FENCE. Day Parkers may join friends camping on the grounds or they can set up a day tent on the lower field down by the rings but it must be under the trees by the tennis court or as directed by the show chairman. DO NOT set up close to the rings as in the past some unattended dogs have disturbed exhibitors by barking. Day tents may be left set up but the club is NOT RESPONSIBLE for their safety and they are left at owner's risk. Day parkers vehicles MAY NOT be parked at a friend's site! There is a \$5.00 per day charge if you set up a day tent on the grounds.
- Exhibitors may bring in day equipment by way of the front gate or through the gates by the tennis court and Obedience ring. Day Parkers MAY NOT drive their vehicle on to the grounds to 'drop off equipment'... people have abused this courtesy in the past. The club will try to help with transport via a golf cart if required.
- The area designated 'The Grove' is reserved for Obedience Rally O and Specialty exhibitors. 'The Grove' is for day setup ONLY. There is limited space so users are asked NOT TO BE GREEDY. Equipment MUST be brought onto the grounds via the bottom fence entrance near The Grove – ABSOLUTELY NO 'DROP OFFS' using a vehicle and NO vehicles are permitted in the Grove area. Please respect the camping area used by our Obedience & Rally organizers.
- Exhibitors or spectators who are designated handicapped may drive onto the grounds down the RIGHT side of the park (by the railroad tracks) and park for the day in a designated area as determined by the show chairman.
- Dogs ARE NOT TO BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN A VEHICLE OR AT A SET- UP. Authorities will be contacted!

NEW CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2006

- 8.2.5 An error in the class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show.
- 8.5.8 In the case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes within the show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition (armband) number. A new entry, along with accompanying entry fees and listing fees (if applicable), will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the opening of the show (see section 8.5.4)
- 8.9.3 When one or more all-breed and/or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the all-breed or Specialty show.
- 12.3.1 A Puppy awarded Best Puppy in Group is NOT required to stay for Best Puppy in Show.

Remember that drops will have to be administered 20-30 minutes before the exam. These drops stay in effect for approximately 2 hours. They make your dogs eyes light sensitive. This could affect your dog's prime capabilities to show his/her best.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$8.82 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 2.3:

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being canceled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.2:

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules

CHAPTER 9 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.
