Regular Classes: Divided by Sex;

Jr (6-9), Sr (9-12), (12-18), Cdn Bred, Bred by Exhibitor, Field Dog, Open, Veteran (7-10 yrs & 10yrs +; may be spayed/neutered), Specials Only,

Non – Regular: Baby Puppy (3 – 6 months), Exhibition Only, Sexually Altered (Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female: Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.) Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team

CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following CKC classes, divided by sex will be provided.

Baby Puppy For dogs 3 months of age but under 6 months of age the day of the show

Junior Puppyfor dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of ageSenior Puppyfor dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age12-18 Monthsfor dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of ageCanadian Bredfor dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded

Bred By Exhibitor for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further

awards

Field Dog (a pass or placement at a CKC or AKC recognized pointing dog field test or field trial is required. Proof must

accompany entry. This class does not win points toward a Championship but does demonstrate the original

purpose for the breeding of Irish Setters")

Open for all dogs

Veteran 7 to 10 for dogs 7 years of age but under 10 years of age

Veteran 10+ for dogs 10 years of age or older

NOTE: Veteran class dogs do not compete for winners, but shall compete for Best of Breed. Dogs

competing in veteran classes may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only for dogs that are registered individually, in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN

number and have attained Championship status. The entry of a 'listed' dog is not allowed.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age that have been spayed or neutered. Points MAY NOT be carried from regular competition judging to the Altered Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed in the regular classes.

Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female.

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes; the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners, and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

NON-REGULAR AND UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Dogs must be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only

Exhibition Only dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-

regular classes

Exhibition Only puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only (3-6 Months) provided the

(3-6 months) owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in Sweepstakes classes if offered. These puppies may not participate in any other

regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades

Stud Dog & Get Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brood Bitch & Progeny Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brace Two dogs of the same breed, not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person

on one lead

Team The requirements for this class are the same as those for the Brace Class except that 4 dogs

shall be entered.

SWEEPSTAKES to be held on Saturday before Conformation

Please Note: All Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the official classes at the Specialty.

This specialty will include SWEEPSTAKES and VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES as follows:

All Sweepstakes classes divided by sex - 3-6 mos, 6 - 9 Mos, 9 -12 Mos, & 12 -18 Mos, on the day of the specialty

All Veteran Sweepstakes classes divided by sex - 7-10 yrs, 10 yrs + on the day of the specialty

PRIZES (Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes)

75% of all puppy sweepstakes entries will be awarded to the winner of the Sweepstakes; and 75% of all Veterans' Sweepstakes entries will be awarded to the winner of the Veteran's sweepstakes. Rosettes 1st to 4th place in each class. —

Rosettes will be offered to the Best in Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes winner. 25% of entry money will be retained by ISCC for administration.

TROPHIES & PRIZES

The support and involvement of all Irish Setter fanciers via donations is welcomed and appreciated. Donations will assist the club in acquiring trophies and rosettes and donors will be identified. A list of trophies and suggested donations may be found on the Irish Setter Club of Canada website.

Through the generosity of these donations the Irish Setter Club of Canada will offer suitable prizes and / or rosettes, for the following awards: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Canadian Bred, Best of Winners, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Puppy, Best Canadian Bred Puppy, Best Canadian Bred in Specialty, Best Veteran in Specialty, Best Field Dog in Specialty, and Best Altered in Specialty, Best Veteran. Rosettes will be awarded for 1 through 4 in each class.

AWARD OF MERIT (Trophy) may be presented at the, judge's discretion at the rate of 1 Award/10 dogs in Best of Breed competition.

SELECT (Rosette) may also be presented at the judge's discretion to a dog and bitch (Special) in the Best of Breed competition.

ISCC BOOSTER trophy for Best in Breed at the All-Breed Host Show on Friday September 2nd All conformation and performance event trophies and prizes must be claimed at the specialty Rosettes will be given for the Highest Qualifying Score by an Irish Setter in Obedience and in Rally Obedience, and for the Irish Setter that achieves the highest score in each class on Friday September 2nd in classes that are offered by the Sagebrush Herding and Obedience Dog Club of BC.

A Rosette and Trophy will be awarded to the Irish Setter that achieves the highest score in the ISCC **Versatility Competition**. The score will be based on achievements in two or more of the following competitions associated with the Specialty: Specialty Conformation, Sagebrush Herding and Obedience Dog Club of BC conducted Obedience, and Rally Obedience classes. JUNIOR HANDLING (DURING THE LUNCH BREAK in the Specialty Ring) Saturday September 3rd Entry Fee: \$2.00

Registration will take place at the Show Secretary's desk up to 11:00am ONLY on Saturday September 3rd. Competition is open to all Juniors 18 years and under. All dogs handled by Juniors must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or for Exhibition Only but need not be owned by the Junior or his/her family. **CLASSES:**

PEEWEE - 4 to the last day before turning 7 Years old (non-competitive)

JUNIOR BOYS AND GIRLS (Novice/Open) 7 years old on the day of competition to the last day of competition before the 11th birthday,

INTERMEDIATE BOYS/GIRLS (Novice/Open) 11 on the day of competition until the last day before the 14th birthday.

SENIOR BOYS AND GIRLS (Novice/Open) 15 on the day of competition until the last day before the 18th birthday.

Trophy & Rosette will be awarded for Best Overall Junior Handler.

Rosettes and prizes will be awarded for 1st in each class and 2nd through 4th will get a rosette. Peewees will receive a prize and a rosette.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points Allocated* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder. NEW: A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the

breed level or group level."

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors patrons, or equipment.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under C.K.C. rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. The ring shall not be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied with a fee set by CKC which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring.
- 10. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club. 11. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from completion by action of the Show Committee
