These fees are per dog, per day, and per class. Pre-entries must be received by October 16, 2010. Entries received after October 16th will be assessed as day-of-show fees. Entries **must** be on the ASCA forms, with the agreement on the back of the entry signed. Duplicate fees and overpayments are not refunded. No refunds after the closing date. Payment must be made in **FULL** with your **COMPLETED** entry form. Post dated cheques and incomplete entry forms will **NOT** be accepted. Tendering an NSF check will be considered non-payment of entry fees and subject to a \$40.00 NSF fee to the ASF of Alberta as well as possible reprimands from ASCA. **Make your cheques payable to: Australian Shepherd Fanciers of Alberta**

AGREEMENT

2. EXHIBITORS AND OWNERS CERTIFY THAT THE ENTERED DOG IS NOT A HAZARD TO PERSONS, DOGS OR PROPERTY.
3. EXHIBITOR AND OWNER ACKNOWLEDGE ALL HAZARDS PRESENTED BY THE EVENT AND THE EVENT PREMISES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE CONDITION OF THE FLOORS, STAIRWAYS, HALLS, LIGHTING, SECURITY MEASURES OR LACK THEREOF, ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES, SHOW RINGS, PARKING AREAS AND THE PRESENCE OF UNFAMILIAR ANIMALS AND PEOPLE; EXHIBITOR AND OWNER ASSUME THE RISK OF ANY HARM ARISING FROM THESE.
