ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the

process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

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BABY PUPPY	dogs between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show (unofficial)			
JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show			
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show			
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show			
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.			
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.			
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs			
VETERAN	dogs over the age of 7 years, does not compete for Winners			
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.			
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.			
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These</u> <u>Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular</u> or <u>unofficial classes</u> <u>or Parades</u>			
BRACE	2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.			
STUD DOG	shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.			
BROOD BITCH	shall be comprised of the brood bitch and 2 or more of her get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The brood bitch may be spayed and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.			

Attention Canadian Exhibitors!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$57.60 + 5% GST.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require</u> an <u>ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.</u>

Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies
vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this
country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs
less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Mt. Cheam Canine Association Premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic</u> notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing <u>date and time</u>. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.
