# EXTRACTS FROM CKC DOG SHOW RULES

### CHAPTER 6.3.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

### CHAPTER 13 - ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEES

### Section 2.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

(a) It is not a Miscellaneous breed

(b) If born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration

(c) If foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$8.48 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

### Section 7.2:

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

### CHAPTER 16 - DISQUALIFICATION

#### Section1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules.

# CHAPTER 18 - EXHIBITORS AND THEIR DOGS

A show giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNNERS shall be as provided bereunder. SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

IF THE DOG AWARDED WINNERS IS ALSO BEST OF WINNERS, BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX OR BEST OF BREED, THE NUMBER OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS WILL DEPEND ON THE TOTAL NUMBER OF DOGS DEFEATED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY FOR THE AWARD.

IN ADDITION TO CHAMPIONSIIP POINTS ALLOCATED AT THE BREED LEVEL, A DOG AWARDED WINNERS WHICH ALSO PLACES IN THE REGULAR GROUP COMPETITION SHALL BE CREDITED WITH THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL POINTS, PROVIDED THAT THE DOG HAS DEFEATED ANOTHER DOG AT THE GROUP LEVEL, SAVE THAT NOT MORE THAN 5 POINTS WILL BE CREDITED TO A DOG FOR A SINGLE SHOW.
