No post dated cheques accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.



Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes – it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

Exhibitors requiring power in their setup area must reserve an outlet. Cost will be \$10/day or \$25 for the weekend. Note requirement and payment on your entry form. If you have already reserved power for the HKC show then ignore this announcement.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR CHINESE CRESTEDS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Baby Puppy Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open (Hairless & Powderpuff)

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

Open Class will be divided into Open Hairless and Open Powderpuff

<u>Note:</u> Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed & colour

<u>Note:</u> All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 3 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Baby Class for Dogs at least 3 months of age up to but not including 6 months.

Junior Class for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Dogs s at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all eight classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 9 years for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years 9 up to 11 years for Dogs at least 9 years of age up to but not including 12 years

11 years of age and older for Dogs 12 years of age and older

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes

50% remaining of the entry fees for a class will go to the class winners

NATIONAL SPECIALTY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights

"A" Classes for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises.
"B" Classes for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCh. degree

or dogs who have earned titles in another country.

Open A for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada.

Open B for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada

Utility A for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D.in Canada.

Utility B for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada

Exhibition Dogs 6 months & over, not in competition.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms

Novice A for dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by

the owner or immediate family member

Novice B For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.

Advanced A for dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and is handled

by the owner or immediate family member

Advanced B For any dog that has earned the RN title.

Excellent A for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and is handled

by the owner or immediate family member

Excellent B For any dog that has earned the RA title.

Please ensure jump heights are indicated on entry form for Open & Utility.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- 3. Telephone and telegraph entries are prohibited under CKC rules.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 5. Changes, cancellations, or substitutions after Closing Date are prohibited.
- 6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.
- 8. All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN number simply do the following. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount prescribed payable to the Canadian Kennel Club Ensure that you provide CKC with your full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a C.K.C. event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for the ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show & Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas
 for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The Specialty Club and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress
 of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is
 effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his
 entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a
 judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.
 (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The Specialty Club and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the
 dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an
 accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or
 civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MGRC and their Show Committee,
 it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.

- Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted on the show premises.
- No dogs shall be permitted to remain in the building overnight
- The precincts of the show shall be the building and the entrances to it.
