- Prairie Dog Sports Barn Hunt Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- If a dog is handled in an aggressive or inappropriate manner a warning may be issued or the team will be asked to leave without refund.
- Everyone is responsible for picking up after their dog. Failure to comply will result in dismissal and no refund will be issued.
- All dogs must be on a short leash (6' or less) and under control at all times, while on grounds, except when in the ring. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dog must run "naked," without a collar/harness. The actual course area will be securely enclosed. No flexi-leads or head halters allowed while on grounds. Per BHA rules, electronic collars/devices are not allowed anywhere on the site this includes electronic bark collars. Prong collars may be used on the site while walking dogs, but are not allowed while the dog is in the ring.
- Show courtesy to all competitors. Manage loud or disruptive dogs. Treat every dog as if they
 were reactive or spatially challenged and remain aware of what <u>your</u> dog is doing at all times.
 Every dog and exhibitor deserve to have a pleasant experience.
- These clinics are held indoors. All dogs must be crated. There will be crating space for entered dogs only. No ex-pens allowed in the building. Please observe marked crating locations. <u>Mats</u> are required under crates. Crates are available for rent at \$15.
- Please bring a chair if you wish, water for your dog and you, treats or toy (reward) for your dog.

Note: Gerbils are used in place of rats in Alberta. We will be using gerbils.

It is expressly understood that participants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. Any participant whose dog(s) create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of Prairie Dog Sports Barn Hunt Club, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Prairie Dog Sports Barn Hunt Club and all persons associated with running this event will assume no responsibilities for any loss damage or injury sustained by participants or spectators, or to any of their dog's or property.

- Barn Hunt Registration Number and Barn Hunt Rules and Regulations may be obtained on the website, www.barnhunt.com.
- Entries made without fees or signature and a completed Waiver and Indemnity Form will not be accepted.
- Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from participating by the action of Prairie Dog Sports Barn Hunt Club. Entry fee(s) will not be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizers. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the event.
- All dogs must be on a short leash (6') and under control at all times, while on event grounds, except when in the ring. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dog must run "naked," without a collar/harness. The actual course area will be securely enclosed. No flexi-leads or head halters allowed within the show building. Per BHA rules, electronic collars/devices are not allowed anywhere on the site this includes electronic bark collars. Prong collars may be used on the site while walking dogs, but are not allowed while the dog is participating.
- Bitches in season may compete. They will run at the end of each class. They must wear "pants" at all times when not being pottied, including on the course. Owners of bitches in season should confine their dog(s) away from the event area and other dogs, post "dog in season" signs in their area, and potty their dog(s) away from other participants. Owners should make their condition known to the event committee prior to the start of the event.
- **Common courtesy:** Participants are responsible to clean up after their dogs. Dispose of waste in appropriate containers provided around the building.
- Possessing or training with personal, live quarry is not permitted on event grounds at any time. Food and toys are not permitted in the ring. Squeaky toys are not permitted in the building.
- Show courtesy to all participants. Manage loud or disruptive dogs. Treat every dog as if they were reactive or spatially challenged and remain aware of what <u>your</u> dog is doing at all times. Every dog and exhibitor deserve to have a pleasant experience.
- These events are held indoors. There will be crating space for entered dogs only. No ex-pens allowed in the building. Please observe marked crating locations. **Mats are required under crates**.
