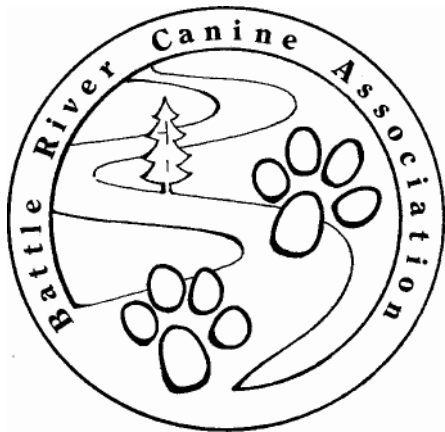

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Conformation Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided there under.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

"In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points (for the highest of the following official breed award). The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included also). In order for a dog be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges - with at least 1 (2 pt) win from the breed or group level; and (2) be individually registered in the recorder of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

CLASSIFICATION – RALLY

Rally Novice A – Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Novice B – Any dog may complete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Rally Advanced A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

Rally Advanced B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Excellent A – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families.

Rally Excellent B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.</p> <p>Novice B for any purebred dog that has not won the title C.D. (Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the “sit” and “down” exercises. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for entry in this class.</p> <p>Open A for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D. in Canada, but that has not won the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its U.D. (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which as won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.</p> <p>Open B for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the “sit” and “down” exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog that has won the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs that have won the title of U.D. may enter this class. A dog eligible for entry in the Utility class is also eligible for entry in the Open B class at the same trial.</p> <p>Utility for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D.X. in Canada. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the “group examination” exercise..</p> <p>Veterans the veterans’ class is performed under the rules described for the novice class. Dogs must be 7 years of age or older PRIOR to the closing. The dog must be entered in one of the regular classes or on Exhibition Only</p>

General Information & Rules

1. **CHAPTER 47.1, CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES** - A judge officiating at a show/trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show/trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show/trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
2. **CHAPTER 21.1 & 21.2, CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES** - “The participation in any manner or in any capacity at a competitive event held under these Rules shall be considered a privilege accorded to any person by the CKC and such privilege may be extended and withdrawn by the Discipline Committee.” “Any person availing himself of the privilege of participating in any manner, shape or form and in any capacity, including that of a spectator at a competitive event held under these rules shall, by such participation, be deemed to have agreed to the authority of the CKC and its Board of Directors.”
3. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED (AFTER THE CLOSING DATE)** In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by act of the show/trial committee or because it has been entered incorrectly except as provided for in “4” below. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of Battle River Canine Association, it is impossible to open or complete the show, NO REFUND of entry fees will be made.
4. **ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE COMES INTO SEASON.** Any female entered in the OBEDIENCE trials who, because of being in season, cannot compete will have the entry fee refunded. A VETERINARIAN’S CERTIFICATE (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 days preceding the trial) must be delivered to the Show/Trial Secretary **PRIOR** to the commencement of that trial’s judging. This does not apply to the Championship show, as this condition is not a disqualification in conformation.
5. **Show Building** will be open at **4PM on Thursday, March 24, 2011 for exhibitor to set-up - NO** Vehicle will be allowed into the building. On the West End of building there is an overhead door on the south side of the building are several doors that exhibitors can back their vehicles up to and off-load their equipment through..
6. **Booth Set-up** will be through designated door at **1 PM**.
7. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday the building will be open at 6:30 AM. The Building will be locked up by 11 PM on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evening.
8. Camrose Regional Exhibition will supply overnight security. They will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.
9. The official veterinarian is “ON CALL”. Anyone who wishes to have their service should approach the Show Superintendent who will arrange for the veterinarian’s attendance. Please note that the person requesting the veterinarian’s service will meet any charge for this service.
10. The **Show Superintendent** will be in full charge of the show/trial, which will be governed by CKC rules. Dogs must be on the show grounds one hour prior to the scheduled judging of their breed. Dogs, which are not required for further judging, may be excused. Dogs must be ready for judging. The club and its superintendent will not be responsible and are not obliged to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class or group. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring.
11. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.

12. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs. Dogs and children must be under control at all times. All dogs must be kept on a max 6' leash, unless competing in the Obedience Ring.
13. Entries will be acknowledged after the closing date - judging schedule and receipt will be mailed.
14. **DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.** Persons exercising dogs outside of the designated area who make no effort to clean up maybe disqualified from that day's show/trial.
15. No dogs will be allowed on the show site unless entered in the show or trial or entered in exhibition only. Any dogs In Transit will be asked to prove age - CKC registration certificate - and must be registered with the Show Secretary Chapter 13.10.1 & 13.10.2 CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES
16. All entries must be typed or distinctly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms. The Battle River Canine does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information on an entry form due to illegibility of information submitted by the owner or owner's agent or entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to enter.
17. **No signs stating dogs/puppies for sale will be allowed on show site.** However communication with the public to promote your particular breed is encouraged.

Benching will be very limited in the Main Pavilion. Additional benching will be available in an adjacent building. Benching will be assigned on a first reserved basis. You can reserve **MAXIMUM** of four spaces.

All funds received for benching will be donated to Alberta Junior Handlers.

\$10.00 will reserve you a 90 square ft space(6' x15'). Each additional space is \$5.00. This space should house up to three regular-sized dogs and your equipment. Please let us know if you have over-sized dogs.
