#### INFORMATION COMMON TO ALL TRIALS

#### Section 19.7 – OBEDIENCE RULES AND REGULATIONS

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, Volunteer or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this has occurred.

**NSF Cheques**: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque for entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees, and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards (6.3.3 of the Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations)

Postdated cheques are not accepted.

**United States exhibitors:** Please purchase a bank draft payable in Canadian funds. If paying instead by personal cheque or money order with United States funds, the amount must be the full amount as if in Canadian funds.

**Bitches in Season**: Refunds for bitches in season will be given provided the exhibitor supplies a veterinary certificate stating that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trials. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the day of the trials or before judging commences on the day of the trials.

#### REGULATIONS APPLYING TO ALL TRIALS

Dogs must be kept under control at all times. Only dogs entered in these trials will be permitted in the Trial Building. Precincts of the trials include the entire area within the Concession building of the Ancaster Fairgrounds.

Only those dogs registered individually with the Canadian Kennel Club, or are eligible for registration with the CKC, may enter. The Listing Fee for a dog not individually registered with the CKC is \$9.30. A dog may not enter the Open or Utility class unless it is registered with the CKC. The entry form must be complete in every respect. Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs. Exhibitors should note that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in the Club's records.

Hamilton Dog Obedience Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other mishap, however caused, to either dog or exhibitor. A dog shall not be touched without permission of the owner or agent.

A dog, which has earned its C.D. degree in Bermuda or the U.S.A. or a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in the Novice A Class, and a dog which has earned its C.D.X. in Bermuda or the U.S.A. or a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in Open A Class. Such dogs must be entered in the B classes respectively.

Novice A: For dogs which have not won the title of C.D. in any country (1)

Novice B: For dogs which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada (2)

Open A: For dogs which have won the title of C.D. in Canada but have not won title C.D.X. in any country (1)

Open B: For dogs which have won the title of C.D. in Canada. A dog may continue to compete in this Class after having won the title of C.D.X. and/or Utility dog. (2)

Utility: For dogs which have won the title of C.D.X. in Canada. A dog may continue to compete in the Utility Class after having won the title of Utility Dog.

The instructions here apply to Novice A and Open A Classes only. Only one dog may be entered in these Classes by any one exhibitor, and every dog must be exhibited by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited any dog through its U.D. title in Canada or elsewhere, shall be allowed to compete as an exhibitor.

If any exhibitor enters more than one dog in the Novice B or Open B classes, he/she must have an additional handler for each additional dog when they are judged together in the Group exercises.

Section 3.6.1 of the Canadian Kennel Club Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations: A judge officiating at a trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the trial to see that the rule is effectively carried out.
