Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Those exhibitors who are LISTED as EITHER THE OWNER OR THE HANDLER/AGENT on 6 or more dogs, or who are co-ordinating a group of individuals setting up together, may request that an area be reserved for them. Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries for the all-breed show. Requests will be acknowledged via email after the closing date and prior to the beginning of the show.

Please note: Exercise pens <u>may</u> be restricted to 1 pen per 3 <u>entered</u> dogs, depending on the size of the entry.

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. Ex-pens are permitted in this area.

There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first served and all equipment MUST BE REMOVED after Best in Show each night. There will be NO exercise pens allowed in this area.

Any equipment left after Best In Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals - and exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted may be asked to leave the show.

JUDGES BIOS'

LUIS MIOUEL PINTO TEIXEIRA

Miguel Teixeira, of Lisbon, Portugal, is one of his country's leading dog fanciers. He is a breeder-owner-exhibitor of Boxers, Cocker Spaniels, Dachshunds, German Shepherd Dogs, Golden Retrievers, and Irish Setters. Mr. Teixeira was approved to judge by the Portuguese Kennel Club and FCI in 1975, and became an all-breed judge 1985.



He has judged in 65 countries on five continents, some 700 dog shows in all. Highlights include World Dog Shows, in chronological order, at Madrid, Valencia, Bern, Brussels, Vienna/Budapest, Milan, Oporto, Amsterdam, Dortmund, Rio de Janeiro, Buenos Aires, and Poznan; and Contest of Champions competitions in Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, Italy, Switzerland, Croatia, Spain, Belgium, Hungary, and South Africa. A civil engineer by profession, Mr. Teixeira has been a member of the Portuguese Kennel Club since 1968. He has served the club as chairman and vice president/judges' committee president.

DENISE CASTONGUAY

Denise has been involved with dogs all her life and fell in love with the Newfoundland at the tender age of 4. It was 24 years later that she finally obtained her first Newf. That was the beginning of a long and continuing love affair with the breed. Under the kennel prefix, CastaNewf, Denise and her husband, Marc bred their first litter in 1989.

Since then, CastaNewf Newfoundlands have earned 23 Newfoundland Club of America Versatile Newfoundland awards, 6 Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada Ultimate Newfoundland



awards, Canada's first Ultimate Newfoundland Excellent award, over 100 championship titles in several countries, and over 350 working titles, to date. Their kennel has produced multiple best in show, best in specialty show and group winners along with best puppy in show, best puppy in group winners, and bred by exhibitor show and group winners. Their kennel also has several NCA Register of Merit Newfoundlands. CastaNewf was the breeder of Canada's #1 Newfoundland and #3 Working Dog in 1999 and also the #1 Newfoundland in 2010. CastaNewf is a Master Breeder with the Canadian Kennel Club and a Breeder of Merit with the American Kennel Club.

Denise loves the versatility of the Newfoundland and strives to produce dogs that can do it all – conformation, obedience, water rescue and draft. She is a water and draft test judge in the U.S. as well as Canada and has judged sweepstakes at regional and national specialties in both countries. Denise is a breed mentor for both the NCA and the NDCC. She has been an active member of the British Columbia region serving continuously in several capacities since 1986 including over 15 years as president. Denise is an active member of the Newfoundland Club of America's Working Dog Committee and she chairs the NCA's Judges Education Committee.

KAREN BREARLEY

My love for dogs began when I was very young as I brought home all the dogs who needed a home. I took my first obedience class with a Golden Retriever named Brew but never showed him. It wasn't until our first Tervuren that I was introduced into the world of competitive obedience. In competition my Tervurens and Pomeranians have brought home high in class and high in trial wins. 

SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS EVENT, BUT MUST BE ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS (Competitive) OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR SWEEPSTAKES

The Bred By Exhibitor Sweepstakes competition shall be for any SIBERIAN HUSKY, owned and handled in the ring by the owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. All dogs **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only.

CLASSES: (divided by sex) Males/Females

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A"/NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A"/OPEN "B" AT SAME TRIAL

<u>PRE-NOVICE</u> – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class NOVICE "C" - This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice -Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS (cont'd)

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'A'</u>- This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'B'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

ADDITIONAL REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following additional regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u> - For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS but rather the winner of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class go directly onto the Best of Breed competition

PLEASE NOTE: SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS-</u> This class shall be for any dog **3 months of age and under 6 months of age** on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed (*This class will be held on completion of Best Puppy in Breed*)

The following unofficial/non-regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

<u>BRACE CLASS</u> - Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily of the same sex) (Note: effective January 1, 2006 – identical ownership NO LONGER applies) <u>SIRE & GET</u> - Shall comprise the Sire and two or more of his Get (Note: Get <u>MUST</u> be entered in a Regular class)

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male or Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed
