DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

A copy of the Canadian Kennel Club Rules pertaining to Conformation Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

The Dog Show Rules state (Dog Show Rules, Section 4.1.3): "a Judge officiating at a show held under theses Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out."

The Dog Show Rules state (Dog show Rules, Section 4.1.6): "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the Canadian Kennel Club within 14 days of the act."

GENERAL INFORMATION

Regular Classes

The following Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

Veterans Class will be divided as follows:

7 years up to 9 years, 9 years up to 12 years, 12 years & older

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs: These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

POINTS

Chapter 20, Section 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show held under the CKC Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship Points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship Points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder:

Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more

Points Allocated: 0 1 2 3 4 5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards. Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set for above.

Non-Regular Classes

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class: shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only.

Brood Bitch Class: shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only.

Brace Class: shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed, colour and identical ownership.

Unofficial Classes

Field Dog: shall be for any dog that has earned a title at WC Test, Hunt Tests or a placement at a Field Trial

Parade of Title Holders: is open to any title holder of any country. Dog must be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition only.

Parade of Veterans: shall be for all dogs and bitches seven years of age or over

Note: Parade of Title Holders and Parade of Veterans ~ owners are requested to submit a resume of their dog's accomplishments a the time of entry ~ limit 100 words

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your Regular Entry Form.



Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex:

Junior Class: for Goldens at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months. Senior Class: for Goldens at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12~18 Open: for Goldens at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best In Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best In Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex In Sweeps.

Veteran Sweeps

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes. Specials, or Exhibition Only, There will be six classes in all, divided by sex:

7 yrs up to 9 yrs: for Goldens at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years 9 yrs up to 12 yrs: for Goldens at least 9 years of age up to but not including 12 years.

12 vrs of age & older: for Goldens 12 years of age and older

Sweepstakes Prize Distribution

For both Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes the Class Winners will compete for Best In Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the Entry Fees for each sweeps class will go the winner of each class.

15% of the Total Sweeps Entry Fees will go to the Best In Sweeps.

The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class except that any nonqualifying score of an exercise will be automatically a zero for that exercise rather than less 50%.

Team Class: this class is open to any four dogs of either sex which have attained no less than a CD degree in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own all dogs, nor that they be of the same sex.

Veterans Class: this class is open to all dogs seven years of age or older, who have attained not less than a CD degree in Canada or USA. It is not necessary for the dog to be entered in any of the official CKC Obedience Classes at the trial. The test shall consist of a complete Novice routine
