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#### **CATALOGUES**

#### **CLASSIFICATION**

The following CKC regular conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy6 months of age/under 9 months.Senior Puppy9 months of age/under 12 months.12 – 18 Month12 months of age/under 18 months

Canadian Bred ....... Dogs born in Canada (champions in any country excluded), Bred By Exhibitor ...... Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder.

Open ...... For all dogs.

Specials Only: ...... Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number

(ERN) and have attained the required points for championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed , Best of Opposite

Sex And Best Puppy(if eligible.)

A dog entered in Specials Only shall be identified by gender in the judges book

Exhibition Only ...... Dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with CKC

#### **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS (ERN)**

Effective Jan 1992, all dogs who are foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN. The ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a copy of the dog's Foreign Registration Certificate, accompanied by the appropriate fee, to the CKC. Please provide your return address. An ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Entry Fee is \$2.00 (includes \$1.00 to be donated to the Provincial Finals Fund), payable at registration between 10 and 11 am on Saturday. First to Fourth in each competitive class will receive a Rosette and the Best overall Handler will receive a Rosette and a prize. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show on that day.

#### **BOOTH SPACE**

The price for the entire show weekend is \$65.00 for an 8 ft x 8 ft area which includes one table, if required, plus \$1.00 per square foot in excess of 8 x 8. Payment MUST be received PRIOR TO SHOW DATE.. Please send payment to Chris Gingell, Box 8478, Cold Lake, AB. T9M 1N2. Ph. 780-639-2164 and indicate whether a table is required.

#### **ELECTRICITY**

#### **BENCHING**

Benching space is limited and will be on a first come first serve basis **THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO SAVING OF SPACE**. Please have your entry receipt available as proof of number of dogs entered. The show committee reserves the right to request that an exhibitor take less space if it is determined that it is excessive for the number of dogs entered. In transit dogs must be benched outside the building. We apologize for finding it necessary to enforce this rule, however, it is as a result of complaints/requests by you our exhibitors. The show committee WILL NOT be responsible for finding benching space for individual exhibitors so please arrive early enough to get yourself set up.

Please ensure your dogs are crated while in motel rooms. Leave rooms without evidence of dogs having stayed and pick up if you exercise the dogs outside. Your consideration will help to ensure the continued availability of the motels for our shows.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Entries will be acknowledged after the closing date.

\*\*\*\*\*\*The building will be open for exhibitors after the Club members have completed setting up the day before the Show (We'll aim for 2 pm but can't guarantee). On show days the building will be opened 1 ½ hours prior to commencement of judging and will be closed at 10.30 pm.\*\*\*\*\*\*\*

The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not assume responsibility nor liability associated with any accident, misfortune or loss to exhibitors, dogs or equipment. There will be <u>NO</u> overnight attendant in the building. Dogs left in the building over night are left entirely at the owner's/handler's own risk.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.

Dogs must be in the building at least one hour prior to judging time.

It is the owner's/handler's responsibility to be at ringside ready for judging. Individual dogs will not be called.

In transit dogs must be benched outside the building as benching area is limited and must be saved for dogs entered in the show. No dog under the age of 6 months is allowed in the building at any time.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs both inside and outside the building. Failure to do so may result in your being expelled from the building. A list of phone numbers for local vets will be posted at the Show Secretary's table. Any charges for vet services will be the responsibility of the person requesting the service.

Any judge officiating at a show held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the show. There will be no smoking allowed in the building.

Children must be kept under control at all times. Children allowed to run in the bleachers during the show may be asked to leave the building.

#### CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded winners at a championship show held under CKC rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder:

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded to WINNERS shall be:

*DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more	
POINTS ALLOCATED	0	1	2	3	4	5	
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<sup>\*</sup>includes the dog awarded winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in sompetition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded Best of Breed att he show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specails Only, shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex, including those competing for Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

If a dogawarded WIONNERS is also awarded Besty of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competions whall be included in the total.

In addition to championships points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, who also places in the regular Group competiton, shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated as the Gropup level.
