The building hours are set by the hiring of city staff to have the facility open, so these hours will be strictly enforced and there will be no exceptions. Dogs will not be allowed to remain in the building after these hours/overnight.

THERE WILL BE NO BATHING OR WASHING OF DOGS AT THE ARENA. There is a Pet Valu on Dawson Rd, if necessary, for bathing purposes.

POWER

The arena is lacking the amount of possible power as compared to Norwest Arena. **Please do not bring wet dogs to dry at the arena.** The power will be specifically designated for the paid reserved grooming in a priority basis, ie: as received. **Please note: exhibitors will need to be willing to share their extension cords when they are not using them. Smaller breeds that can use battery fans, please do so.** Exhibitors are responsible to bring their own extension cords and be prepared for a long distance as the electrical supply is not necessarily located in a near convenient spot.

Cleanup

As usual, this show is a self-clean show and facility. Ring stewards will hold dogs, for exhibitors/handlers to clean up the ring area. Cleaning supplies will be provided. Outdoor cleanup is also required, so please pick up after your dogs and there will be **NO RELIEVING DOGS ON THE BUILDING WALLS!!**

Parking

You will notice upon arrival, that a number of “city no parking signs” have been placed on the south side of the facility. **Exhibitors will be able to drop items off only at the large doors, but must move their vehicles to the north parking lot immediately. There will be no waiting for setup before moving your vehicle. This will be monitored by the show committee.** We also need to be respectful of the church parking area, especially on Sunday. Any parking in their lot on other days is at your own risk.

All campers are to check in with the show secretary before they set up their rigs so they ensure they are in the correct designated area.

Ontario Smoking Law

It is illegal to smoke on and within 20 metres of children’s playgrounds and publicly owned sport fields and surfaces (e.g., areas for basketball, baseball, soccer or beach volleyball, ice rinks, tennis courts, splash pads and swimming pools that are owned by a municipality, the province or a postsecondary education institution)

ADDITIONAL TIDBITS

There will not be a canteen open at the arena, but there are multiple options close to the facility including a nice lunch at the 55+ facility next door. We will have coffee available each morning for the exhibitors in the arena canteen area.

There will be a private judges' area marked out for the lunch break, please honor their privacy during their breaks. Pictures can be arranged outside their lunch period. Please take and review your pictures as soon as you can, as there is no expended time at the end of each day to do so. Especially Sunday after BIS, as we MUST be out by 4pm.

Numbers will be available at the Show Secretary's table. The same number will be used all weekend.

For the American exhibitors, there have been no changes with regards to border Identification needed for all persons and dogs.

We have not heard of any dog food restrictions as of late.

Weather wise, we are having some lovely afternoons, but the morning and late evening temperatures are quite cool.

The club is looking forward to a great show. This is a higher entry than our previous shows and I know we can all welcome new exhibitors and out of town guests. Although there may be issues that arise, there is no problem that cannot be solved. Be courteous to all, and if you need assistance come to the show secretary's table. New club members are covering some positions they are unfamiliar with, so please be patient.

I hope I have not made errors in the judging schedule, but if you notice something, do not panic!!! Just email me and I will check your entries. Those little boxes do a number on my old eyes after a while. Please specify your name, email address and the dog's name so I have a reference to look items up. I honestly do not remember everyone's "special 4-legged sweetie" and their name and class, but I am always happy to help.
