

CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

- **PLEASE NOTE:** We plan to run the Official OPEN stake to completion in the morning. Singles will run in the afternoon. Roll call for Singles will **not** be **before** 1.30 p.m. each day. Please see the cover page for the close of Post Entry and Roll Call times.
- **Rolling Inspection** – Check in for Inspection as you arrive, with your dog(s). Inspection ends ½ hour after entries close each day (Roll Call). It is your responsibility to take your dog for inspection prior to Roll Call.
- The terrain is pasture land, quite a distance from any roads. Field is not fenced but the property is.
- All hounds will be run in trios or braces, twice, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and their entry fee will NOT be refunded. No exceptions will be made.
- All handlers **MUST** use a slip lead when releasing their hounds.
- Hounds may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion.
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and will have their entry fee returned if notice is given to the secretary **prior** to roll call. A Veterinarian certificate may be required.
- The Chairman may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$10.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any hound loose on the field at any time between Roll Call and the completion of Best in Field or Regular classes.
- There is **NO** shade or water available, so come **PREPARED**.
- Best in Field will be offered only on Sunday, May 31, 2015. Breed Winners from both Saturday and Sunday will be eligible to compete.
- You may camp overnight but, with the exception of a Port-a-Potty, there are no camping facilities. The location is **Extremely** difficult to get in and out of with a trailer so please take a look before committing to taking a trailer in.
- There will be a concession with home cooking and baking available on the field.

EQUIPMENT AND FIELD CONDITIONS

An electric drag will be used for the Regular Classes and Singles.

A continuous loop may be used for the Puppy and Veteran stakes.

Attention all Foreign Exhibitors!

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables foreign-born and foreign-owned dogs to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN mail or Fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with payment in the amount of \$58.85 Canadian funds, payable to the CKC. This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event to avoid cancellation of Awards. Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An **annual** non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that “ these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.”

It is in your best interest to acquire a Basic CKC membership at \$50 +GST to cover all your dogs as opposed to the Non-Member Participation Fee of \$55+tax per dog.

CERTIFICATION RUNS

ALCA will hold Certification runs **by appointment** Friday evening and after the completion of the Regular Trial on Saturday evening. Cost is \$15.00. Please make your own arrangements for a suitable dog to run yours with. Call Ed at 780 922-5418 to make the arrangements.

CKC definition:

7.1.1 (a) A hound must be tested with another dog, not a kennelmate, preferably of the same breed, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. Hounds must be a minimum of 11 months old prior to being certified, and must run a normal course of 600 yards (548.4 m) in order to be certified.

ELIGIBLE ENTRIES

To be eligible for this trial, your dog MUST be a purebred of one of these following breeds:

AFGHAN, BASENJI, BORZOI, DEERHOUND (SCOTTISH), GREYHOUND, IBIZAN, IRISH WOLFHOUND, ITALIAN GREYHOUND, PHARAOH, SALUKI OR WHIPPET.

All entrants must be registered or be eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club.

Altered or neutered hounds **may** compete. Hounds presently disqualified under C.K.C., CSFA, ASFA or AKC rules are not eligible. **Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada.**

CLASSES AND STAKES OFFERED

Stakes : Breed and Mixed

Mixed Stake is for multiple breeds with entries of 3 or less upon ALL owner's agreement.

Lure Trial Official Classes Offered

OPEN - Offered for all eligible hounds one year of age or older on the day of the trial, including Field Champions of Record.

Lure Trial Unofficial Classes Offered

Best In Field: Offered on Sunday only to include all Best of Breed winners from both Saturday and Sunday.

Singles Offered on Saturday and Sunday.

Puppies (6-9, 9-12, 12-18 months) Offered Saturday, after Singles.

Veterans (dogs 7 years old on day of trial) Offered Saturday, after Singles.

Kennel, Club and Breeder Stakes Offered on Sunday. Enter before Post Entry closes for Official Classes (this is limited to dogs competing in Official classes).

Pre-entry, first hound \$20.00 (includes \$ 4.72 CKC fee)

Pre-entry, each additional hound, same EXACT owner(s) \$18.00 (includes \$4.72 CKC fee)

Post entry (after May22, 2015), per hound \$25.00 (includes \$4.72 CKC fee)

Listing Fee (G.S.T. Included) \$8.82 each per day

Singles \$15.00

All other unofficial classes requiring an entry \$5.00 per entry

(Puppy, Veteran, Stakes)

Dogs not individually registered with the CKC are considered **Listed**. A Listing fee must accompany each entry for each Trial. Sorry, no Fax or E-mail service is available!!

No postdated cheques and NO credit cards will be accepted

Payment in full must accompany all entries. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any N.S.F. cheque.

Overpayment of entries will be considered a donation to the Trophy Fund.

UNOFFICIAL CLASS SCHEDULE

Singles Competition

Is your dog DQ'd, declared ineligible or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Dogs will be run individually and scored. They will run after the Open stake has completed its preliminary round and then again after the Open stake has completed its final round. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. Dogs must wear a blanket. No points are awarded and all ties will be settled by a coin toss. A ribbon will be awarded to 1st to NBQ. Your dog will be only given TWO opportunities to chase the lure each time it comes to the line. Handlers will not be able to run/walk the course with their hounds.

Puppies and Veterans, run singly (Saturday after completion of Singles and any Certification runs).

Entry must be received by 1.00 p.m. Saturday.

Kennel, Club and Breeder Stakes

Entry must be received by 9.00 a.m. Sunday, May 31, 2015

FIRST TIME ENTERED HOUNDS

As of July 1st, 1998, all hounds competing for the first time must be certified prior to entry in a Field Trial. If this is the Hound's first Trial you must submit the Certificate to the Field Trial Secretary (3, 3.1.2 (a) CKC Field Trial Regulation).

ROLL CALL TIMES AND RUNNING ORDERS – **NOTE the CHANGE**

We are offering a Rolling inspection between the time you arrive and Roll Call for both the official classes and singles.

Official Class Post Entry closes at 9.00 a.m. on **Saturday and Sunday**. Roll Call at 9:30 a.m.

Singles Post Entry closes at 12.30 p.m. on **Saturday and Sunday**. Roll Call not before 1.00 p.m..

Breed running order will be posted at Roll Call.

Puppy Stakes and Veterans will be run **AFTER SINGLES** on Saturday.

Best in Field will be run on Sunday only. It includes all Best of Breed and Stake winners from both Saturday and Sunday. It will be run **BEFORE SINGLES**.

PRIZES

Rosettes and a Trophy will be awarded to **BOB** and **BIF**.

Rosettes will be awarded to **First** through **NBQ** placements.

A Qualifying Ribbon will be offered for each **qualifying score** earned by a hound which has not previously earned the Novice Courser Title. Please let the Field Trial Secretary know if your hound qualifies.

A Rosette will be awarded to the highest scoring **Singles** run dog.

A Ribbon will be awarded to **2nd** to **NBQ** for the **Singles** run.

A Rosette will be offered for the winner of each of the **Kennel, Breeder** and **Club** stakes.

A Rosette will be awarded for **Highest Score for a Hound competing in its First Trial** (Total of qualifying scores for the weekend, adjusted for judge's averages).

Aggregate Award: A large Rosette & Trophy will be awarded for High Point Aggregate. This will be awarded to the hound entered and qualifying in **all** five ALCA trials for 2015. Award will be determined by total qualifying scores adjusted for judges' average.

A Rosette for Best Puppy in field. Ribbons for 1st to NBQ in each age group will be awarded.

Ribbons and trophies not collected on the field will not be mailed. They will be considered a donation back to the club.

Extract from CKC Field Trial Rules and Regulations for Lure Coursing

Chapter 9.5 Placements and Awards

9.5.1 Hounds which are not to be scored are not to be added to a course.

9.5.2 Championship points in regular stakes shall be awarded on the basis of the following:

First Place:

Four times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 40 points.

Second Place:

Three times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 30 points.

Third Place:

Twice the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 20 points.

Fourth Place:

Points equal to the number of hounds competing in the stake to a maximum of 10 points.

Next Best Qualified Dog (NBQ):

No points awarded.

Qualifying Score (QS)

No points awarded.

9.5.3 A hound shall not receive a placement or be awarded points if it does not score at least 50 per cent of the total possible combined scores. Hounds which do not receive placements under this provision will, nevertheless, be considered as having been in competition for the purpose of awarding points. If a hound is excused in the preliminary run, that hound will not count as having been in competition when computing championship points. Hounds that are dismissed or declared ineligible shall count as having been in competition when computing championship points.

ATTENTION

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteers or any participant at the event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

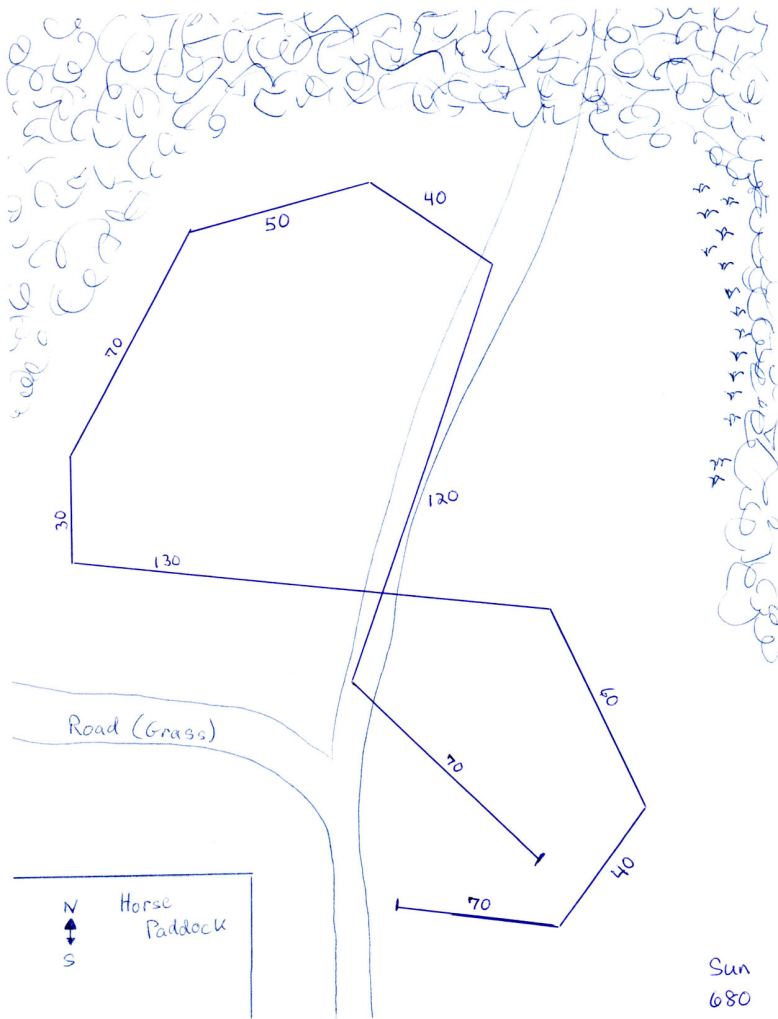
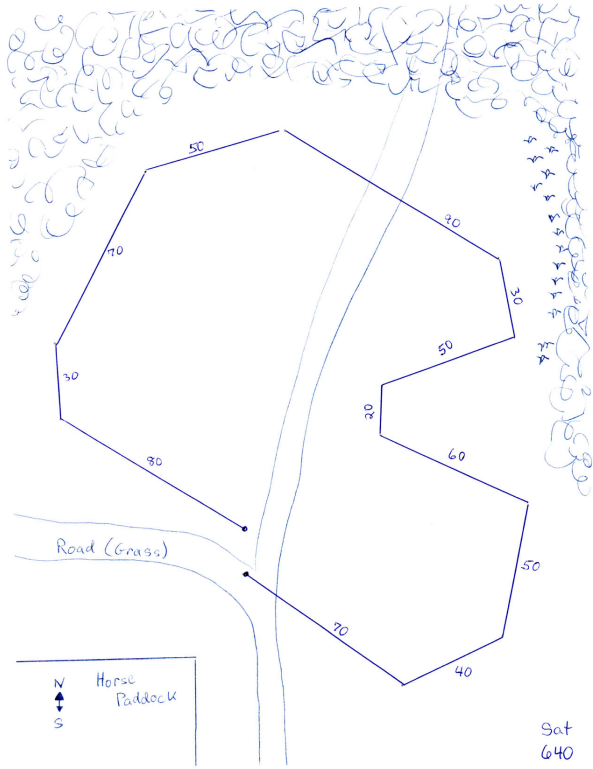
9.7.3 Course plans which have been altered from those published in the premium list must be posted on the field in a prominent location. A test run must be announced and made immediately before or after roll call. Any person who, after seeing the test run with the course plan alterations, decides not to run his hound has the option of withdrawing his entry and having the entry fee refunded.


NOTE: NO refunds will be offered prior to the running of the test dog each day.


NO refunds will be offered for the puppy or veteran run prior to setting up the course.
