

**DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:
Westbound on Hwy #1**

Take exit #160 that says "Laidlaw, Hunter Creek, Rest Area", go under the freeway to the second stop sign and turn right. You are now running parallel with the freeway heading towards Chilliwack. Go about 4 km, turn left at McKay Rd.

Eastbound on Hwy #1

Take exit #153 that says "Jones Lake, Laidlaw". The exit veers to the right. You are parallel with the freeway, still heading towards Hope. Go about 2 km, turn right on McKay Rd.

Input address: 58428 McKay Road - tell your GPS to search all cities in BC - if it offers you Fraser Valley - choose that. The Garmin did not find it in Hope, or in Laidlaw - but it found it in Fraser Valley, British Columbia!

A Suitable Prize and/or Rosette will be awarded to the following

High in Trial (each trial)
Reserve High in Trial (each trial)
High Belgian Shepherd each day
High Australian Cattle Dog each day
High Cardigan Corgi each day
Reserve High in Trial Cardigan Corgi (Monday)

"The Pepsi Trophy for Stockmanship" will be awarded to the dog/handler team showing good stockmanship throughout each day. This is a perpetual trophy donated by Anne Gunn & Downriver Farm

Section 18.1 of the CKC Herding Rules states:

"The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC."

Section 15.7 of the CKC Herding Rules states:

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward volunteer or competitor at a Herding Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

Rule books are available through the CKC office.

Please Note: There have been many changes to the CKC Herding Rules that took effect January 1, 2012. Please ensure that you review a 2012 Rule Book so that you are aware of requirements for all levels.

Stock specific titles are now available for Arena trials.

For dogs that have previously earned titles (prior to January 1, 2012), if the owners would like a stock specific certificate, the owner will have to submit evidence to the Results Department in Shows and Trials that the qualifying legs were all achieved on the same stock. This can be copies from Premium Lists, catalogues or whatever shows the stock that was used.

For dogs that currently have legs towards a title (earned prior to January 1, 2012), when the dog has received enough legs for a title, CKC staff will check to see if they can determine if it was all on the same stock. If they can, then a stock specific title/certificate will be issued. If not, then a generic title/certificate will be issued. If the owner can provide evidence that all legs were earned on the same stock, they can submit it to Head Office and they will review it.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB
Non-Member Participation Fee
(Effective January 1, 2011)

Policy:

Non-member participation fee

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Information:

A non member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.

There are 2 options for non-members:

a) Join the CKC

b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.

The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs, titles, or awards earned and is assessed against the owner(s).

Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.

Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog.

Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc. earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.

The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated.
