High in Trial:

- Awards will be made for Official Classes only. Qualifiers in the unofficial classes will receive a green ribbon but will not be eligible for any special awards.

- All trophies and awards must be picked up by the end of the last trial on Sunday May 29th. None will be mailed. Trophies or awards not picked up become the property of the Club.

Rules

- The Swansea Dog Obedience Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of, an accident or misfortune however caused to dogs, exhibitors or property. Dogs must be kept under control at all times.
- 2. A judge officiating at an Obedience Trial held under these Regulations shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the Obedience Trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Trial to see that this Regulation is effectively carried out. The Obedience Chairman shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of these Regulations, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this Regulation has been violated.
- 3. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Refunds for bitches in season will be given provided the exhibitor supplies a veterinary certificate stating that the bitch is in season after the closing date of the trials. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of judging for the day.
- 4. The listing fee for a dog not registered with the CKC is \$9.40 per trial (includes HST). A dog must be listed unless it has an individual registration number or an <u>E</u>vent <u>R</u>egistration<u>N</u>umber (ERN) issued by the CKC. Only dogs eligible for registration with the CKC are eligible to compete at these Trials. Failure to obtain an ERN within 30 days of the event will result in any scores being cancelled by the CKC. Please note that dogs are not allowed to compete above the Novice level without a CKC registration number or an ERN. Applications for an ERN can be obtained from the CKC.
- 5. Effective January 1, 2011 the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members, US residents or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.
- 6. One dog only may be entered in the Novice "A" and Open Class "A" by any one exhibitor, who must handle the dog in all exercises. Every dog in these classes must be handled by its owner or a member of the immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its utility degree in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in these classes.
- 7. A dog which has earned its CD in the USA, Bermuda or a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in Novice "A", and a dog which has earned its CDX degree in Canada, USA, Bermuda or a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in Open Class "A". Such dogs must be entered in the respective "B" Classes.
- 8. If any exhibitor enters more than one dog in the Novice B or Open B classes, he/she must have an additional handler for each additional dog when they are judged together in the group exercises.
- 9. Only those dogs entered in the Trials (official or unofficial classes) will be allowed within the precincts of the trial. This area includes the obedience floor, the arena stands and surrounding concrete areas outside the arena boards and glass enclosure.
- 10. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- 11. The Obedience Trial Chairperson shall have full control of the Trials. Emergency Cell # contact Trial weekend (289) 242 5827.
- **Please Note:** Pine Point Arena does not allow alcoholic beverages on the premises in accordance with the provincial regulations.
