Working spots are limited to 8 people/dogs per session. Total working time is 8 hours.

All working spots are \$300.00

STARTERS/ADVANCED HANDLING

Saturday and Sunday, October 21 and 22 (8.00 am to 12.00 pm)

This session is appropriate for starter/advanced dogs as well as dogs who are getting ready to compete.

Working spots are limited to 8 handlers/dogs. Total working time is 8 hours.

All working spots are \$300.00

GAMBLE

Friday, October 20 (8.00 am to 12.00 pm)

This session is appropriate for dogs who are gambling at an advanced or masters level.

Working spots are limited to 5 handlers/dogs. Total working time is 4 hours.

All working spots are \$125.00.

PUPPY/YOUNG DOG

Thursday, October 19 (8.00 am to 12.00 pm)

Working spots are limited to 4 handlers/dogs. Total working time is 4 hours.

All working spots are \$150.00

I am offering a payment plan for the MASTERS and STARTERS/ADVANCED seminars. A \$100.00 *non-refundable* deposit is due with this application to hold your spot. You are, of course, welcome to send full payment at this time. However, if you would like to spread the cost out, the following payment schedule is available:

Payment and Refund Policy

Soaring Paws Agility (SPA) budgets for and hires seminar presenters based on filling a specific number of working spots. Presenter, presenter's travel costs, and facility costs are the same amount of money regardless of how many people attend the seminar/ event. A waiting list will be maintained, however, if you cancel *refunds will only be issued if I can fill your working spot*. Further, I would like to continue to offer the payment plan option at future events to keep agility affordable and accessible for everyone. Please ensure your payments reach me by the specified dates. If I do not receive one of your payments, your working spot will forfeited and no refund issued unless I can fill your spot.

To hold a working spot in the seminar, a cheque or interac payment for the *non-refundable* deposit of \$100.00 (or the full amount if you are in the gamble or puppy session) and a signed and dated copy of the waiver (attached with the entry form) is required with your entry.
