DOG ID CARDS: Dogs may register for a CARO ID number at the trial.

CONFIRMATIONS

Confirmations will be emailed after the closing deadline. You must provide an email address for confirmation. Tentative schedule of events will be included with confirmation.

SITE

Glade Acres, 2242 Upper Glade Road, Glade, BC. There is limited shade.

Dry camping is available at \$10 per night

Directions from Highway 3A between Castlegar and Nelson: Turn onto Glade Ferry Road (across from the Esso Station). Continue down Ferry Road to the ferry. Take ferry across Kootenay River. After ferry, turn left at first intersection onto Glade Road. Then turn right onto Morraine Rd, then part way up the hill, turn left onto Upper Glade Rd. Glade Acres (Dan and Glenda Harris) is on the right at 2242 Upper Glade Road).

Crating & Set-Up: The site will be available after 2pm on Friday. Lost or damaged personal property is not the responsibility of Love 2 Play or the Harris'.

AWARDS

CARO qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog/handler team who achieves a score of 170 or better (except for Team where a qualifying score is 180 or above). There are no q ribbons for working level but Rosettes for titles.

MOVE UPS

Move-ups from prior trials must be reported no later than one week prior to the trial. Please contact the Trial Secretary. We will attempt to also accommodate same day move-ups. NOTE: CARO rules state that you can compete concurrently at two levels (e.g., Novice and Advanced) but any qualifying scores earned at the higher level will only 'count' IF you complete the lower level title at the same trial.

FOOD

Bring your own food as there are no local restaurants.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteer assistance will be required for time keeping, gate stewarding, and setting up of courses. Each time a person volunteers for a role (per round), they will receive a raffle ticket with a chance of winning a prize.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of CARO Rally Obedience rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following rules regarding entry:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in these trials. Where a bitch comes into season after the entry of the bitch has been submitted, a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the Trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the Trial, whereupon the entry fees will be refunded.

Dogs with disabilities are allowed and encouraged to compete. Please let the trial secretary know of modifications that may be needed. The dogs must not show evidence of being in pain or discomfort. The judge shall excuse any dog that does so.

Owners with disabilities are allowed. Owners with disabilities shall provide the judge with a written description of how they intend to perform any of the course exercises that must be modified. The modification must be approximate to the best of the handler's ability. The judge must approve and initial the modifications and attach the written description to the score sheet.

All dogs must be registered with CARO to compete in the obedience trial. If you do not have a CARO number, you may fill out an Individual Dog Application Form, and accompany it with a cheque made out to CARO for the amount required to the Trial Secretary. The Trial Secretary will then submit this application with the trial results.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs. **Obstacles and stations** shall be chosen from those described in the rules and regulations of CARO and shall conform to this organization's specifications.

It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs and/or children. Any competitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave. NO REFUND of fees will be paid. All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when they leave the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior when leaving the ring will be disqualified and/or required to leave the trial site. NO REFUND of fees will be paid. Exhibitors must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great venue available for future dog events!

There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/ injured dogs if the Trial Secretary is notified prior to the trial date and provided with a vet's certificate.

Trial organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry and if an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.

No Physical corrections allowed on trial grounds.

All competitors will be encouraged to volunteer to help the trial run smoothly.

Allowable Collars All dogs shall be shown in a flat buckle or snap collar or plain harness. NO choke collars, prong collars, shock collars, no pull harnesses, martingale collars / leads or head halters are allowed. Leashes should be made of fabric or leather and be long enough to provide adequate slack. Dogs at the Advanced and Excellent level are not required to compete with a collar; but must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Upon successful completion of an exercise, the owner may choose to briefly feed, pet or touch the dog as a reward at the Novice and Advanced levels. Toys may also be used. Food may NOT be used as a lure to help the dog complete an exercise. Food or toy rewards must be contained in pockets or hidden treat pouches on the opposite side from the dog and only be present in the owner's hand in between exercises. Any petting, touching, or feeding that significantly interrupts the flow of performance shall be scored accordingly.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death resulting at any time therefore sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this round, howsoever such injuries, death, or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

I (we) further acknowledge that I (we) have read, understand and will abide by the Official Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Association of Rally Obedience and the provisions for entry as set forth in the Rally Test Schedule of which this entry form is part. I (we) acknowledge and represent that the information supplied by me (us) herein is correct to the best of my (our) knowledge; if any portion of this information is found to be invalid or insufficient to establish the validity of my (our) entry, such finding shall render my (our) entry invalid in its entirety, for which there shall be no refund of fees paid.

Further, I (we) represent that I am (we are) the owner(s) of the dog listed heron, or that I am (we are) a family member of the dog's owner as stated and allowed in the CARO rules, and that I (we) shall hold the hosting club, CARO, Love 2 Play Dog Training and Glenda and Dan Harris, including their officers, directors, employees, and agents and their spouses, harmless from any liability or claim made by the dog's owner(s).
