INTACT & ALTERED CONFORMATION INFORMATION

Regular Conformation Classes:

All Regular Classes, Intact & Altered, divided by sex:
6-9 months; 9-12 months; 12-15 months; 15-18 months
Novice; Canadian Bred; Bred By Exhibitor
Open Blue Merle; Open Red Merle; Open Black; Open Red
Winners; Best of Breed

Class winners to compete for Winners Dog / Winners Bitch. Winners Dog & Winners Bitch will compete with Specials for BOB, BOS and BOW.

Non-Regular Conformation Classes:

2-4 month puppy; 4-6 month puppy, divided by sex; class winners to compete for BOB Puppy & BOS Puppy
Veterans 7-9 years & 10 years and over, divided by sex; class winners to compete for BOB Veteran & BOS Veteran

***** There will be two special non-regular classes – Silhouette and Movement – as part of Show Two on Saturday May 19. See below for full descriptions *****

Regular Junior Handling Classes:

Novice Junior 8-12 years; Novice Senior 13-17 years;

Attention All Regular Intact and Altered Class Entries:

ALL dogs in Regular Conformation Classes must be at least 6 months of age or older on the day of the show and must be ASCA® registered.

All Pre-entries must be accompanied by a photocopy of each dog's ASCA® Registration. Day-of entries will also require proof of ASCA® registration.

All Entries Are Non-Refundable.

A \$40 NSF charge will be applied on all returned cheques.

Payment IN FULL must accompany all entries and be in Canadian funds. We will accept e-transfers (coasc@bell.net), bank drafts, personal cheques, and money orders in Canadian Funds. Post-dated cheques are not accepted.

U.S. exhibitors may pay by personal cheques payable in U.S. funds, for the full amount of the entry. Cheques in U.S. funds will be accepted at par and may not be discounted.

Please make all cheques payable to COASC.

No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA® Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from any ASCA® program; or a person not in good standing with ASCA®.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the show committee, ASCA®, the show veterinarian or the judge.

Anyone having any dogs with or exposed to any communicable diseases within 30 days of these shows is NOT allowed to attend per ASCA® Rules.

JUST-FOR-FUN CLASSES!

Enter our NON-REGULAR CLASSES TAKING PLACE DURING SHOW TWO

Judge: Valerie Yates

Cost: \$2 per entry per class

Each 1st place winner receives 50% of the total class entry fees

SILHOUETTE: Dogs will be stacked four-square and the judge will look at each dog's outline and determine how well it matches breed type.

MOVEMENT: Each dog will be gaited down and back and around to determine which dogs best typify the correct gait as outlined in the breed standard.

Open to any Australian Shepherd. All dogs are in the ring together; males enter first, followed by bitches. There will be no hands-on exam of any dog. Winners will be placed 1st through 4th and awarded a non-regular flat ribbon. Entry numbers and placements will be marked in the judge's books.

Ring will be **outdoors on grass** on the playing field opposite the agility rings.

Reserved Aussie grooming space with complimentary electricity will be available indoors.

Day-of entries will be taken from 7:30 am to 8:30 am and during BOB judging of shows 1 and 3, closing ½ hour before shows 2 and 4 begin.
