Agility Class Descriptions

Junior Handlers Program: is open to all youths 17 years of age and under.

Regular Classes: These classes are open to all dogs, 18 months of age or older, as described within the current AAC rules.

Special Classes: These classes are open to all dogs. Handlers running dogs in Special classes will have the option to move into Regular classes once during the dog's career. Such a switch will require the handler to notify the AAC via the appropriate Regional Director, but will not require justification or approval. Any switch from Specials to Regular cannot be made mid-trial. Other than this one time move, a dog may no longer compete in the Regular class level once entered at an official trial in the Special class level; however, they are eligible for the Veteran class level.

Veteran Classes: These classes are for dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in any Standard Agility Class and for dogs five years of age or older who have competed in the Specials Agility Class for a minimum of 12 months.

Starters Standard Classes: These classes are open to all dogs that have not received three qualifying scores under two different judges in these classes or have not earned their ADC title.

Starters Games Classes: These classes are open to all dogs that have not received a qualifying score in that games class.

Starters Gamblers Class: This game demonstrates the handler's strategy and the dog's ability to work at a distance from the handler. The object of the game is to accumulate as many points as possible in the opening sequence and successfully complete the gamble.

Starters Snooker Class: This game demonstrates the handler and dog's versatility as they work together against the clock. The object of the game is to accumulate points by successfully completing as many obstacles as possible in the prescribed order within time.

Starters Jumpers Course: This game demonstrates a dog's natural jumping ability. The dog is required to complete a course comprised of jumps and tunnels as prescribed by the judge.

General Notice to Exhibitors:

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- This event is held under AAC rules and regulations and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.
- All dogs must have an official AAC identification card, which must be produced at measure in. Dogs without a
 card, under two years of age or without two official measurements on their ID card, must be measured before
 competing. A dog over 23" at the withers can have a signed ID card before two years of age.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs, and/or children.
 Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe and disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave the trial grounds and NO REFUND of fees will be made.
- Exhibitors must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dog.
- The host club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- After closing date, refunds will only be given to competitors if a bitch comes into season or the dog or handler is
 injured sufficiently to prevent them from competing. The trial secretary must be informed prior to the trial date
 and a certificate from a veterinarian or doctor must be provided.
- Any dog earning a title after the closing date of this trial is eligible to move up to the next level as long as the
 exhibitor notifies the Secretary at least ONE WEEK prior to the trial. A dog earning a title on Saturday of this trial
 is allowed to move up on Sunday as long as the Secretary is notified before the completion of the trial on
 Saturday.
