To qualify for entry, the General Agreement must be signed and the entry must be received with payment by May 16th, 2018.

All entrants are required to help at the trial. There will be a signup sheet at check in.

CHECK IN / MEASURING:

Please note, all dogs must have at least one measurement for the new jump heights before they may participate in a trial in 2018. Check in and measuring starts at 4:45 on Friday and 7:15 on Saturday and Sunday. Please make sure you have your dog's AAC ID card with you. First dog on the line on Friday at 5:30, 8:00 am Saturday and Sunday. A copy of your dog's completed 2018 AAC measurement card may be emailed to the trial secretary before the trial, otherwise the card will need to be presented at the trial.

EQUIPMENT FAMILIARIZATION:

7:15 am - 7:30 am Saturday.

CRATING:

Indoor and outdoor crating space is available.

MOVE-UPS:

Same day move-ups for all rounds.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place and for all qualifying runs. Titling ribbons will also be awarded to dogs that earn a title. There will be helper's draws each day.

CONFIRMATION:

Confirmation will be e-mailed to you. If you do not receive a confirmation letter 1 week prior to the trial date, or if there are errors,

please notify the Trial Secretary as soon as possible. This will help avoid delays the day of the trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

This event is open to all dogs at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the MC. No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No toys or food on course during familiarization. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made. Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs.

There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.

Entry fees: 13.00 per run; more than 7 runs, same handler, one dog or multiple dogs, 12.00 per run; 11.00 for FEO runs.
