Crate Availability:

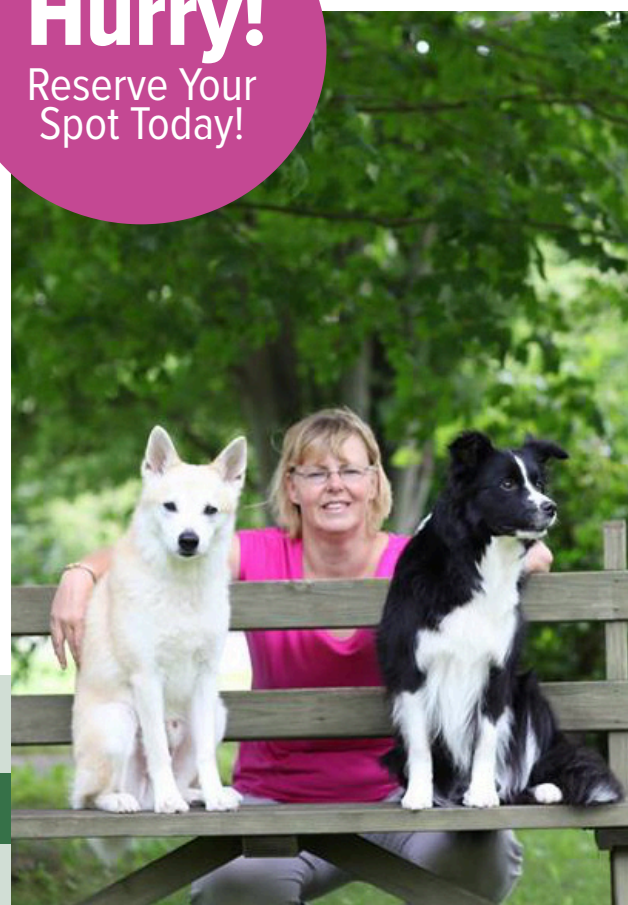
On site - book ahead if you want a crate for the weekend. Using crates on site, provide more working room for the dogs.
