Linda began in AKC Conformation as a teenager with Australian Terriers. She bred/owned/handled the first triple titled Aussie (Conformation, Obedience, Earth Dog). Saluki's entered her life 46 years ago and from a small breeding program there have been multiple Champions in the ring and field, including Specialty winners, dual titlists, tracking and obedience titled dogs.

Linda was the first person to earn the AKC UD on a Saluki (2 individuals) and also earned multiple Will Judy/Dog World Awards and all breed Highs in Trial in the US and Canada (and the only Canadian UD titled Salukis we think).

Initially, Linda was approved to judge Salukis and Australian Terriers and currently judges BIS, Hound and Herding Groups in the US, all levels of obedience and rally, lure coursing and junior showmanship. She is the only AKC judge fully approved for this combination of events. She has judged multiple specialties including having been twice selected by her peers to judge Conformation at the National Saluki Specialty. Out of country assignments include Australia, Belgium, Canada, England, Germany, Finland, New Zealand and Sweden. (In addition to judging the Herding Group at this show, Ms. Scanlon is judging the Alberta Lure Coursing Association Specialty and NACA Obedience and Rally.)

I have served as President of the Afghan Hound Club of Canada in the past, and also was President of the Brantford and District Kennel Club.I have also acted as Show Chairman and Show Superintendent for the Brantford and District annual all breed show.

Since 1971, I've had a very successful breeding program with Afghan Hounds under the "Jolterra" prefix. Along with Afghans, I usually had one other breed, on a limited scale, including American Cocker Spaniels, Miniature Poodles, Cesky Terriers, and English Pointers. I started judging in 1989 and became an "all breed judge" in 2008. I have judged all across Canada, in the USA, Denmark, Germany, Thailand, Australia, and New Zealand.

Some of my hobbies include long distance running, cross country skiing during our winters, basketball, and golfing. I also enjoy home renovations and reading.

Ken Cook - Sweepstakes

"Swiftess" Borzoi began in 1974 with a rescue from the SPCA "Alexia". Like a good number of enthusiasts my first Borzoi was put through every form of event that was available including Scent hurdle racing and trialing her at the Utility dog level. While there has not been a litter at Swiftess for some time, I am proud to say that Swiftess remains a strong influence in a few well-known kennels.

I have also owned and exhibited Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Afghan Hounds, Whippets and even a Rottweiler. A founding member of ALCA I became a Lure coursing judge early on in the CKC's involvement in the sport. Later I became a CKC licensed conformation judge for the hound group. Judging specialties was extremely gratifying, but to survive in Canada as a judge it was necessary to move on to judge to breeds I would never be qualified to judge. I resigned from CKC judging because of this. In the last decade I have focused on exhibiting exceptional dogs to the fancy. The result has been winning many specialties and twice having the top winning Hound in Canada.



ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events will no longer require a CKC registration number **but will require an ERN** - **Event Registration Number**. An ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the *Animal Pedigree Act* but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own ERN number. A CKC ERN registration form and ERN fee details can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca To obtain an ERN, mail or fax the Canadian Kennel Club the ERN form with a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate plus a certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.**

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may EITHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an *Event Registration Number* or a *Miscellaneous Certification Number*;
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
