- To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list. Section 1 Chapter 13.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY THE ENTRY FEE.
- 3. TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 4. Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where there is a conflict between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.
- 5. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Cancellation of any entry after the closing day is prohibited.
- 6. The Ottawa Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.
- 7. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT WILL BE IN FULL CHARGE OF THE SHOW which will be governed by C.K.C.Rules.
- 8. I dentification cards and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
- 9. The person accompanying the dog must show the I dentification card before the dog is allowed in the show, and unless a dog is entered officially, it will not be allowed in the show precincts.
- 10. All dogs must be exercised in the exercise pens provided for that purpose. Plastic bags will be available at each entrance.
- 11. Dogs need only arrive 15 minutes before scheduled judging time, and will be excused, each show, when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
- 12. The Ottawa Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- 13. The show will not start before 8:00 am.
- 14. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- 15. To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loud-speaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for

alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
