These fees are per dog, per day, and per class. Pre-entries must be received by March 9th 2012. Entries received after March 9th are assessed as day-of-show fees. Entries **must** be on the ASCA forms, with the agreement on the back of the entry signed. Tendering of an NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and may be subject to action by ASCA. There will be a \$40.00 fee charged for any NSF cheques tendered.

If your dog is entered only in ASCA classes and not entered in the CKC show in Camrose, you must enter in Exhibition Only on a Battle River Canine Association (BRCA) entry form to have your dog in the building prior to the conclusion of the judging for CKC Best in Show. Puppies are not allowed in the building until after CKC Best in Show. 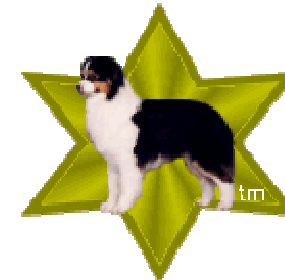
