CKC RULES REGARDING APPROACHING JUDGES AND REGARDING INDIGNITIES

- 4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.
- 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Veterans Class	Dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show.
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Baby Puppy	A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Altered Class	For sexually altered dogs only.
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper fees and submitted on an OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORM. If more forms are required, please photocopy. Include postal code and telephone number. Please type or print clearly.
- Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted, and all "NSF" cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00. All fees must be paid before the show. The SSKC does not accept credit cards.
- The SSKC reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how the error was made or who made it.
- Any overpayment of fees will be considered a contribution to our trophy fund.
- To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trial Secretary after the closing time and date.

The Entry Line Inc. logo features a dog's head. JUNIOR HANDLING

Judge to be announced. Held under CKC Rules. Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Show Secretary. A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the Show provided he/she has the consent of the owner or agent to do so. If necessary, due to conflict, substitution of dog will be allowed. Dogs being used in the competition, MUST BE OF APPROPRIATE SIZE AND TEMPERAMENT FOR THE JUNIOR HANDLER.

4.1 Class Structure (Age Requirements)

- (a) PEE WEE CLASS - For handlers 4 years of age up to 6 years of age. Optional and noncompetitive. No placements are to be awarded, participant ribbons, rosettes and token prizes may be presented.
- (b) JUNIOR NOVICE CLASS - For handlers 7 to 10 years who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.
- (c) JUNIOR OPEN CLASS - For handlers 7 to 10 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Junior Novice Class, OR any handler wishing to enter this level. It is understood that once that handler has entered and competed in the Open Class, he/she may not compete in the Novice Class again.
- (d) INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS - For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.
- (e) INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS - For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have won six first places in the same class with competition.
- (f) SENIOR NOVICE CLASS - For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.
- (g) SENIOR OPEN CLASS - For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he/she has enough experience to compete at this level.

4.2 BEST OVERALL

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the show. Dogs being used in the competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler.

Refund Policy

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. However, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry, and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation are appreciated. Thank you.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

- 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from zero (0) to five (5)) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.
- 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

- 15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.
Clarification:
Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex
- 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 15.1.12 A dog awarded Winners that also placed Reserve Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with four (4) championship points in addition to any points earned at the breed and group level, to the maximum allowed championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.13 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must:
- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three (3) different judges;
 - (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);
 - (c) have earned at least one (1) two (2)-point win either at the breed or group level.
- 15.1.14 The Board interprets the words “earn at least ten (10) championship points under three (3) different judges” to mean:
- (a) At a single breed National Specialty, the male designated Reserve Winners Dog will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Dog to have received five (5) points.
 - (b) At a single breed National Specialty, the female designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Bitch to have received five (5) points.
 - (c) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level;
 - (d) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing;
 - (e) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh)

- 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.
- 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.
- 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group and Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.
- (a) Grand Champion Point System
- Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of same sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh: Select dog = # of regular class dogs + # of specials dogs – 1, Select Bitch = # of regular class bitches + # of specials bitches – 1.

- (b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at Group level for all levels of GCh:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

(d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group and Best In Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

(c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group and Best In Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group and Best In Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)

15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

(a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of ten (10) dogs have competed)

(b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.

(c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, three (3) Group wins, or three (3) Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE:

2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until December 31, 2022.



Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs which are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership: for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed"; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

CKC HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises, and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The building will be open at 7 a.m. with judging commencing at 8 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. Friday set-up is from 5-7 p.m.
2. Only dogs entered in the Shows and Trials will be allowed in the building.
3. Dogs will not be allowed in the building overnight.
4. Prong or Spike collars will not be permitted at this venue.
5. Judging will proceed without any dog that is not present when called by the Ring Steward. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers should judging times conflict.
6. All Group judging will begin on completion of Breed judging within each group. Best In Show, Best Puppy In Show, and Reserve Best In Show will follow all Group judging. Reserve Best In Show will immediately follow Best In Show.
7. The Superintendent will be in full charge of the Shows and Trials. To accommodate ALL exhibitors, the SSKC reserves the right to limit set-up space, size, and location of crates. Use of Ex-pens is not permitted. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.
8. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular Official Classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.
9. The SSKC will use all due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of, an accident or any misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons and will not be responsible for equipment left on premises.
10. The SSKC greatly appreciates your co-operation in cleaning up after your dogs.
11. Canteen facilities will be available.
12. Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events. A copy of these Rules is available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
