This is a people only lecture. This lecture will cover the topic of how our dogs learn. We will address positive reinforcement vs punishment-based training technique and why we at Oxford Dog Sports embrace positive reinforcement methods. You will also learn about Pavlov and Premack, classical conditioning, perception modification, past learning history, extinction bursts, conditioned reinforcers (word markers or clickers), overshadowing of cues and what that means, parallel lives (emotional triggers), trigger stacking, timing/presentation/placement of rewards, conditioned emotional responses, splitting vs clumping (what does that mean), and so much more. This is all the theory you need to understand how your dog learns and lead you to a successful training journey and a joyful, collaborative relationship with your dog.
