

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable about AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following rules regarding entry:

Bitches in season are permitted to compete in this trial. Special requirements as per below:

- Handlers are required to notify the trial secretary they will be running a BIS at the event as soon as it is known.
- Handlers should minimize exposure of their BIS to other dogs and limit their movements about the grounds.
- Competitors that have BIS will be allowed to withdraw and receive a full refund.
- Kootenay Underdogs allows any competitor wishing to withdraw (with refund given) due to BIS being on the premises.
- Competitors will be notified there is a BIS on site.
- A protective mat shall be used at the start line. Kootenay Underdogs will provide the mat. However, the competitor may choose to bring his/her own mat.
- Kootenay Underdogs will allow the BIS to run without panties.
- BIS will run as a group at the end of each class.
- "BIS" will be noted next to the dog's name on the gate sheet so that other competitors, ring crew and the Judge(s) are aware.
- BIS must use a designated separate relief area.
- BIS must wear protective panties when not running or not within the designated relief area.

All dogs must be registered with AAC to compete in the agility trial. Photo of AAC ID CARDS (both sides) must be emailed directly to the Trial Secretary <u>immediately</u> after your entry form is submitted if we do not have a record or your dog still needs to be measured.

Measuring - If your dog is under 2 years old or has not had their first measurement, you must have your dog measured. Limited measuring will be available on Friday before the start of the trial and the morning of Saturday/Sunday. In order to limit unnecessary contact and to eliminate the need for measuring at every trial, judges will provide a one-time measure for dogs under 2 years. A temporary measurement card will be e-mailed to the handler to be used during this time. Dogs under 2 years of age may compete with their temporary card until they reach 2 years of age, at which point they will require an official measurement. Judges will resume signing Dog ID cards for dogs 2 years and older. Dogs over 2 years of age must be measured until they have their final height circled on their ID card.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.

You must not attend the trial if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or feeling unwell or have been in contact with someone that has the virus. You will be asked to leave the trial site immediately if you are visibly unwell.

- Always maintain a minimum 2 meters distance from other individuals: be respectful of other peoples' bubbles!
- Be mindful: avoid unnecessary or inadvertent touching of equipment on course or surfaces anywhere on the trial site.
- Bring an adequate supply of masks, gloves, and disinfectant for your personal use during the trial. Masks are optional during walk through and judge's briefing.
- Anticipate that many of the usual routines we have come to expect at trials are changing. Be gracious and kind in adapting to the 'new normal' of agility trialing. Without changes we will be unable to continue with any trials.
- Remind one another to adhere to the protocols and measures that are in place at this trial to ensure everyone is safe. This is a shared responsibility. Recognize that people may inadvertently slip up and offer a gentle, kind reminder.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to this organization's specifications. All contacts are rubberized; Kootenay Underdogs does not have electronic timing. Please note, a Gallican "barn door" tire will be used and a broad jump MAY be used.

It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs and/or children. Any competitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave. NO REFUND of fees will be paid.

All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when they leave the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior when leaving the ring will be disqualified and/or required to leave the trial site. NO REFUND of fees will be paid.

Trial organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry and if an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.

Collars in the ring – dog will be allowed to wear a close-fitting collar, with no attachments, in the ring.

All entry forms must be complete and accompanied by the proper fee to be valid.

All competitors are expected to volunteer during the trial.

These trials cannot happen without your ongoing support as volunteers.

Teams competing 'For Exhibition Only' (FEO) may bring a non-audible toy into the ring to tug with or toss to their dog.

Obstacle Familiarization: Available for all dogs on contact equipment only and is dependent on equipment included in the first runs. Preference will be given to starter dogs.

Regular Runs: \$16.00 including GST. Junior Runs: \$14.00 including GST.

FEO Runs: \$12.00 including GST. FEO Teams may bring a non-audible/non-food toy into the ring.

Confirmations

Confirmations will be emailed. We reserve the right to cancel the trial at any time up to and including the day of, if any conditions are present that would deem it unsafe to go ahead. In which case full refunds will be provided to all entrants.

Refunds – because this event is strictly limited, partial refunds will be issued for trial cancelation by the handler, or medical/veterinary reasons after the closing date or a full refund if their spot can be filled from the waitlist. Full refunds if the trial is cancelled by the club.

Crating – Competitors can use shelters or crate in cars at the venue. Please keep areas in and around your crating site clean and free of debris. **In order for us to continue to keep using this venue for future events, please make sure you clean up after your dog.**

SITE

Balfour Daze: There will be a one day festival starting Saturday morning and running until 6 or 7 pm that evening. There will be vendors, food trucks, a live band, silent auction, beer garden, etc.

Directions from Nelson: Follow BC-3A to Busk Road (towards the Kootenay Lake Ferry Landing), continue on Busk Road, turn left on Charles Street and turn right at pickleball/tennis courts.

Directions from Kaslo: Follow Balfour-Kaslo-Galena Bay Highway/BC-31S, turn left onto Busk Road, turn left on Charles Street and turn right at pickleball/tennis courts

Amenities: Washrooms on site, running water, large gazebo/shelter, parking and dry camping. There is a gas station, a small grocery store, and bakery within a few blocks as well as accommodations (hotels and Airbnb) and RV parks within 10 minutes of the venue.
