***AWARD OF MERIT** To be made at the Judge's discretion and after selecting Best of Breed, BOS, Select Dog, Select Female and Best of Winners. A Specialty Club may offer one (1) Award of Merit for every ten (10) dogs competing at Best of Breed level**. Any dog, from any class, who competes at Best of Breed level, is eligible to receive an Award of Merit.

**The total number of Awards of Merit that may be awarded shall be based upon the number of Chow Chows entered in the Specials Only class as at the closing date AND present in the ring for competition at Best of Breed level. The 1:10 count shall NOT include Winners Male, Winners Female, Veteran Male, Veteran Female, any dog moved to the Specials Only class after the closing date or any dog entered in the Specials Only class who is excused or disqualified from competition at Best of Breed level.

CONFORMATION ENTRY CLASSES

The following conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non- regular or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

REGULAR OFFICIAL CLASSES (divided by sex):

Junior Puppy – dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy – dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 Months - dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred - dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards. Should the owner/breeder be unable to handle the dog in this class, the dog may be moved to the Open class (at least one hour prior to the judging of the breed).

Open - all dogs. The open class shall be divided by colour red, black, any acceptable color other than red or black (i.e. blue and cinnamon) and cream. The open class shall also be divided by coat variety: rough and smooth.

Veterans – CKC Dog Show Rule 12.2.1(h) – dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in Veterans may be spayed or neutered. The winners of each class in each sex will compete for Best of Breed.

Specials Only – dogs that have recorded CKC registration, Event Registration (ERN), and have attained the required points for championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, and Best Puppy if eligible. After awarding Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best of Winners, the judge may chose a Select Dog and Select Bitch.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

Baby Puppy Class – dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The awards for this class are: Best Baby Dog and Best Baby Bitch, and Best Baby Puppy in Breed.

Puppies 4-6 months (Exhibition Only) – dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.

Exhibition Only - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in non-regular classes, if provided for in the premium list.

OPTIONAL CLASSES:

Altered – dogs over 6 months of age that have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure. CKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 13 (13.1 to and including 13.8). Altered dogs must be entered in a regular class as outlined in the CKC conformation rules OR in Exhibition Only to be eligible to compete. (Chapter 12.9.2)

Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date and time will not be accepted. Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.**

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you! The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of that person's dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to 24 hours before the start of the show.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show

USE OF YOUR IMAGE AND/OR YOUR DOG'S IMAGE

The CCWC Ltd. and/or its agents, may take candid photos, win photos, or videos of this event, including but not limited to, images of the exhibitors and their dogs. Such images may be published without notice to you. By entering this CCWC Ltd. event, you consent to publication in all forms, and waive all rights to such images and agree that CCWC Ltd. may use such images for its promotional or educational purposes, and without notice or compensation to you.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. An ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the *Animal Pedigree Act* but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own ERN number. A CKC ERN registration form and ERN fee details can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca> To obtain an ERN, mail or fax the Canadian Kennel Club the ERN form with a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate plus a certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.**

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may EITHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS:

1. This specialty show ("the event") is an official CKC approved event. The CCWC Ltd. adhere to the CKC Conformation Dog Show Rules, a copy of which can be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club, #101, 5397 Eglinton Avenue West, Etobicoke, ON M9W 5K6 or online at www.ckc.ca.
2. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with, and abide by, the CKC rules pertaining to this event.
3. The Event Superintendent will be in full charge of the event.
4. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the event date, please contact the Show Secretary.
5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Event Superintendent shall promptly report to the Event Committee, who shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, upon receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
6. CCWC Ltd reserves the right to remove any person from the event for reasonable cause.
7. Any dog excused by the Event Superintendent for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the event.
8. The event committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
9. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The CCWC Ltd. will not be responsible for, and is not obligated to provide, any service to notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging.
10. Exhibitors and handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are Mountain Time.
11. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for the welfare of their dogs and children.
12. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors we require that you keep the grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
13. Entry fees will not be refunded if the Event cannot open, or be completed, by reason of covid regulations, changes to venue use policy, riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of CCWC Ltd.
14. Entry fees will not be refunded if the event is cancelled, if an exhibitor is directed by the Event Superintendent to leave the show or if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
16. The CCWC Ltd. is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
17. CCWC Ltd. will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of accident or misfortune to dogs, or exhibitors.

AGREEMENT & WAIVER

I (we) acknowledge that by entering this event, I (we) shall abide by all Government of Alberta health rules and regulations in effect at the time of the show, I (we) acknowledge that the CCWC Ltd. adheres to the "CKC Conformation Dog Show Rules" for this event, and that I am (we are) responsible for being familiar with the CKC Conformation Dog Show Rules. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win a prize, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the CCWC Ltd. their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, volunteers or show secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing, including but not limited to death, disease, illness or medical expenses or death or injuries caused by a dog, while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the CCWC Ltd. or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees on a solicitor and client basis) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEX) for details.
