PLEASE NOTE: each day is a separate test.

IMPORTANT: **TCN Number**: A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) has been established by The Canadian Kennel Club and MUST ACCOMPANY the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. An additional fee of \$10.50 (incl GST) per dog per each event entered during the field test is required in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records. Please visit www.CKC.ca to obtain a TCN

Entries may be made on-line with our event partner www.DogShow.ca commencing 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 4, 2024 and closing at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 11, 2024 Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in approximately 7 hours of judging time. A wait list will be established as tests fill

Running order will be drawn following the close of entries. Running order will be emailed to handlers thereafter.

NOTE: In the case of electronic or telephone entries, the entry is not considered complete until fee is paid and a signed entry form is received by the Test Secretary. All completed entry forms must be in the hands of the Field Dog Test Secretary and entry fees paid in full before a dog will be allowed to run.

TEST INFORMATION:

- **Courses & Birds:** Chukar, partridge and/or quail will be released. The tests will be over a single course with birds released along the course. The CPDC reserves the right, in case of a bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.
- There will be **no horses** on course. All participants & spectators must be on foot. All dogs will be handled on foot.
- **Gallery:** At the judge's discretion, a gallery of spectators may be permitted to follow the test dogs. Spectators must wear blaze orange, remain together at all times and shall follow the directions of the judge, marshal & gunners. All others must remain in the camp area.
- All participants (handlers, judges, gunners, marshals and gallery) who will be on course for FD, FDA or FDX (all tests with shotguns being used) are required to wear a blaze orange outer garment (vest/jacket/shirt) and required to wear blaze orange headgear.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in approximately 8 hours of judging time.
- Starting times will be announced with the running order. (Earliest start will be 8:00 am.) Running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.
- FDJ & FD dogs will have 20-30 minutes to complete all aspects of the test. FDA dog will have 30-40 minutes to complete all aspects of the course. FDX dogs will have 30-45 minutes. Dogs will be run individually in the FDJ & FD Tests; FDA and FDX dogs will be run in braces. The length of the test will be at the judge's discretion.
- **Firearms**: Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, FDA & FDX, shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by official gunners only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired by the handler please provide your own starting pistol.
- Bitches in season will not be permitted to run.
- **Collaring** a dog will be allowed only at the judges' instruction
- Approved tracking collars will be permitted.
- **Training or exercising** of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test weekend (from Friday evening until completion of judging on Sunday).
- **Smoking** is prohibited except in your vehicle.
- There is **no camping** on the grounds. Outhouse is provided.
- Food: There will be no food on site for purchase. Lunch will be provided to judges and volunteers.
- Prizes: Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs.
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. All entries for the Field Test are accepted on condition that the CPDC, its officials and members, and the land owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this field test. All minors are strictly required to be under the direct care and supervision of a parent or guardian.

The tests will be held on the property of Wessex Game Birds. The club is grateful to have the use of these grounds and asks for your cooperation in keeping them free of litter by using garbage bags provided. Pick up after your dog.

Parking will be restricted to the marked areas. A map or directions to the grounds will be provided to participants after the draw.
